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REQUESTED ACTION

The New Hampshire Lottery Commission requests to place this item on the Consent Calendar.

The New Hampshire Lottery® Commission respectfully requests authorization to pay Fiscal Year 2018 membership dues in the amount of \$20,000 to the North American Association of State and Provincial Lotteries (NASPL), Concord, Ohio (Vendor Number #206566). This will be effective upon Governor and Council approval for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018. **100% Lottery Funds.**

Funds to support this request are anticipated to be available in the account titled Lottery Operating Costs, in State Fiscal Year 2018, pending legislative approval of the next biennial budget.

EXPLANATION


