Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

#### REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Mary F. Stewart to Position #9U543 (Appropriation #02-20-200510-26110000-013-500132) as an Attorney at a salary level of \$95,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or April 22, 2022, whichever is later.

#### **EXPLANATION**

Ms. Stewart, a resident of Bow, earned a Bachelor of Science in Finance and Management from Lehigh University in 1985, and her Juris Doctor from Vermont Law School in 1993. She alternated between private practice and judicial clerkships at the United States Bankruptcy Court over the course of her legal career. She clerked for the Hon. James Yacos from 1993 to 1995, operated her own law office from 1995 to 1997, and served as an Advocate at the Legal Advice and Referral Center from 1997 to 1998. She was associated with Feniger and Uliasz, PLLC, from 2004 to 2005 and Firstenberger and Stewart, PLLC, from 2004 to 2005. After a six-month temporary clerkship with the Hon. J. Michael Deasy in 2005, she resumed private practice as a solo practitioner from 2005 to 2018. Ms. Stewart most recently clerked for the Hon. Bruce Harwood from 2018 to 2021. She was a Member of the National Association of Consumer Bankruptcy Attorneys from 2006 to 2018, the New Hampshire Pro Bono Advisory Board from 2011 to 2012, and the National Association of Consumer Advocates from 2014 to 2018. She has been an active member of the American Bankruptcy Institute since 2009. Ms. Stewart was honored with the Distinguished Pro Bono Service Award for Consumer Bankruptcy in 2010. In light of Ms. Stewart's experience, I am requesting she be appointed as an Attorney at a salary of \$95,000. She will be assigned to the Consumer Protection Bureau. A copy of her resume is attached.

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RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.
