Requested Action

Authorize the Department of Safety, Division of Emergency Services & Communications, to enter into a no-cost Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Lakes Region Mutual Fire Aid Association (LRMFAA) for use of the PSIC (Public Safety Interoperability Communications) System in order to reach its communities via LMR (Land Mobile Radio). Effective upon Governor and Council approval through December 31, 2025.

Explanation

This MOU gives LRMFAA the ability to reach the communities it serves via the established PSIC radio system. The access is required as LRMFAA has just built out a new, IP-based system which requires the link located along the PSIC radio network to connect with their equipment at their location in Laconia. The PSIC system is an established radio network connecting other public safety users maintained by the Department of Safety, Division of Emergency Services and Communications. This agreement is needed to provide efficient, cost-effective radio communications to support the protection of life and property executed by the agencies making this agreement. This cooperation is in the best interest of the public.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

THIS MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) is made and entered into between the State of New Hampshire Department of Safety, Division of Emergency Services & Communications (DESC) and the Lakes Region Mutual Fire Aid Association (LRMFA), collectively referred to as "the Parties."

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the PARTIES have maintained a collaborative relationship for over 25 years to support the mission of public safety and have used a shared communications site that is hosted and located at the State Police at Tenney Mountain in Grafton County;

WHEREAS, LRMFA needs to utilize the PSIC (Public Safety Interoperability Communications) in order to reach its communities via the LMR (Land Mobile Radio);

WHEREAS, it is a public safety interest to have LRMFA utilize the link ("the link") from the communications site located at the Blue Job State Forest on Blue Job Mountain in Farmington, NH ("Blue Job communications site") to Strafford County Sheriff's Office in Dover, NH;

WHEREAS, many entities have used the Blue Job communications site,

WHEREAS, the DESC has solely paid for repair and maintenance of the equipment related to the Blue Job communications site despite its use by many users;

WHEREAS, equipment is needed for LRMFA's access to the link;

WHEREAS, the DESC wants other users to share in the cost of the equipment and maintenance related to the Blue Job communications site;

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED by and between the Parties that they shall continue their arrangement as follows:

- 1. LRMFA and DESC are both aware and in agreement that the link is a shared microwave link with other public safety users, and LRMFA has a designated capacity of 10 mbps on this link.
- DESC shall be responsible to maintain the Blue Job communications site, provide electricity to the site, monitor and maintain compliance with applicable state and federal regulations and allow the LRMFA to have access to LRMFA's equipment at all times. LRMFA will, at its own cost, supply any and all equipment needed for it to access the link.

- 3. LRMFA shall be responsible to have its site equipment maintained by a qualified technician or vendor, notify the DESC of any changes in configuration and equipment to ensure compatibility with existing DESC equipment and tower loading requirements. LRMFA shall cause no interference with any other user's equipment.
 - a. Only DESC personnel will be allowed to access the configuration of the DESC equipment for changes or maintenance at either end of the microwave link.
 - b. Notification to DESC shall be via telephone during normal business hours to the Radio Maintenance Shop at 603-271-2421 or after hours at 603-271-6911.
- 4. In the event that either party determines that it is necessary to terminate this MOA, the terminating party shall give 30 days' advanced written notice to the other party. Written notice to the DESC shall be to the Director, DESC 33 Hazen Drive Concord, NH 03305.
- 5. This MOA does not waive or limit the sovereign immunity, or any immunity, to which the State of New Hampshire, its agencies, officers, trustees, officials, and employees are entitled.
