

BOARD OF AUCTIONEERS MINUTES

NH Real Estate Commission – Director Beth Emmons wrote to each Board of Auctioneers member regarding the auction of property by licensed real estate agents who are not licensed auctioneers, which was a question asked of Richard Berman in one of his Real Estate Education classes. The Board of Auctioneers discussed the situation and determined that the answer lies under RSA 358-G: 1.
