### REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 94:6, the Commissioner of the Department of Revenue Administration respectfully requests to place Ms. Debra J. Piaseczny at the second step for the position of Multi-Entity Tax Auditor, of the Audit Division, (9U585), unclassified salary grade CC, earning \$60,845.19 annually, effective September 4, 2013, upon Governor & Council approval. Funding is 100% general funds.

### EXPLANATION

The Department of Revenue Administration requests, pursuant to RSA 94:6, the Governor and Council approve an entrance salary higher than minimum, \$53,814.90, within the established range for position #9U585, Multi-Entity Tax Auditor, for Ms. Debra J. Piaseczny.

Ms. Piaseczny was employed at the Department of Revenue Administration for nine years in various auditing positions, most recently that of a Multi-State Field Auditor. Ms. Piaseczny possesses a Bachelor of Science in accounting and has over 12 years of experience in performing financial audits. The minimum salary for 9U585, Multi-Entity Tax Auditor, unclassified CC, is less than her prior salary at the Department of Revenue Administration.

In her prior position at the Department, Ms. Piaseczny performed field audits of businesses throughout the United States for compliance with the various NH taxes. (Business, Communications Services, Real Estate Transfer, Tobacco, Interest & Dividends and Medicaid Enhancement). Ms. Piaseczny's abilities as an auditor have also been enhanced by her most recent employment as an auditor with the Public Utilities Commission.

In the Multi-Entity Tax Auditor position, Ms. Piaseczny will perform field audits of taxpayer records at the taxpayers' place of business. Ms. Piaseczny's prior experience of working in the field and her understanding of state tax law, the Internal Revenue Code and related regulations, and court decisions in the area of federal and state taxation, will allow her to be an immediate asset to the Division. She will be able to start conducting field examinations immediately.

Based upon Ms. Piaseczny's experience with the Department and NH tax laws, the Department believes that she should be placed into the Multi-Entity position, unclassified grade CC at the second step, \$60,845.19.
