REQUESTED ACTION

Approve Carol B. LaMarche 2001 Revocable Trust's request to perform the following work on Lake Winnipesaukee in Moultonborough. File # 2018-00373. This project will not have significant impact on or adversely affect the values of Lake Winnipesaukee.

Remove a 2 foot x 25 foot finger pier, install a 6 foot x 40 foot seasonal dock with a 6 foot x 12 foot access walkway southwest of an existing 64 linear foot "L" shaped breakwater, with a 6 foot gap at the shoreline, a 4 foot x 30.5 foot cantilevered pier accessed by a 6 foot x 30.5 foot cantilevered pier, a 6 foot walkway and stairs over the bank, a seasonal boatlift, and two seasonal personal watercraft lifts along the shoreline on an average of 154 feet of frontage along Lake Winnipesaukee, in Moultonborough.

The New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) imposed the following conditions as part of this approval:

- All work shall be in accordance with revised plans by Watermark Marine Construction dated April 26, 2018 as received by NHDES on April 26, 2018
- 2. This permit is not valid and effective until it has been recorded with the appropriate county Registry of Deeds by the applicant. Prior to starting work under this permit, the permittee shall submit a copy of the recorded permit to the NHDES Wetlands Program by certified mail, return receipt requested.
- 3. The 2 foot wide finger pier shall be removed prior to the construction or installation of any new structure on the frontage.
- 4. All development activities associated with this project shall be conducted in compliance with applicable requirements of RSA 483-B and N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Env-Wq 1400 during and after construction.
- 5. Work shall be carried out in a time and manner to avoid disturbances to migratory waterfowl breeding and nesting areas.
- Appropriate siltation and erosion controls shall be in place prior to construction, shall be maintained during construction, and shall remain in place until the area is stabilized. Temporary controls shall be removed once the area has been stabilized.
- 7. Only those structures shown on the approved plans shall be installed or constructed along this frontage. All portions of the structures shall be at least 20 feet from the abutting property lines or the imaginary extension of those lines into the water.
- 8. No portion of the new seasonal pier shall extend more than 40 feet from the shoreline at full lake elevation (Elev. 504.32).
- 9. All seasonal structures shall be removed for the non-boating season.

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10. All activities shall be in accordance with the Shoreland Water Quality Protection Act, RSA 483-B. The owner is responsible for obtaining any Shoreland Permit that may be required per RSA 483-B, for construction, excavation or fill that will occur within the Protected Shoreland.

EXPLANATION

The NHDES Wetlands Bureau approved this project on May 10, 2018. The NHDES supported its decision with the following findings:

- 1. This is a major impact project per Administrative Rule Env-Wt 303.02(d), modification of a docking structure associated with a breakwater.
- 2. The need for the proposed impacts has been demonstrated by the applicant per Env-Wt 302.01.
- 3. The applicant has provided evidence which demonstrates that this proposal is the alternative with the least adverse impact to areas and environments under the department's jurisdiction per Env-Wt 302.03.
- 4. The applicant has demonstrated by plan and example that each factor listed in Env-Wt 302.04(a) Requirements for Application Evaluation, has been considered in the design of the project.
- 5. The applicant has an average of 154 feet of shoreline frontage along Lake Winnipesaukee.
- 6. A maximum of 3 slips may be permitted on this frontage per Rule Env-Wt 402.13, Frontage Over 75'.
- 7. The proposed docking facility modifications will result in a docking facility providing 3 slips as defined per RSA 482-A:2, VIII and, therefore, meets Rule Env-Wt 402.13.
- 8. The Department finds that because the project is not of significant public interest and will not significantly impair the resources of Lake Winnipesaukee a public hearing under RSA 482-A:8 is not required.

Application file documents are being forwarded to the Governor and Executive Council in connection with their consideration of this matter pursuant to RSA 482-A:3,II.(a) as it is a major project in public waters of the state.

We respectfully submit this request for your consideration.





Project Description:

Install a 6ft x 40ft seasonal crank-up dock while

maintaining existing breakwater and breakwater dockage.

The NH Natural Heritage database has been checked for records of rare species and exemplary natural communities near the area mapped below. The species considered include those listed as Threatened or Endangered by either the state of New Hampshire or the federal government. We currently have no recorded occurrences for sensitive species near this project area.

A negative result (no record in our database) does not mean that a sensitive species is not present. Our data can only tell you of known occurrences, based on information gathered by qualified biologists and reported to our office. However, many areas have never been surveyed, or have only been surveyed for certain species. An on-site survey would provide better information on what species and communities are indeed present.

This report is valid through 1/10/2019.






Lake Winnipesaukee
