EXPLANATION

Approval of this request will enable the State to pay annual membership dues to National Association of Medicaid Directors for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. National Association of Medicaid Directors is a bipartisan, professional, nonprofit organization of state Medicaid agencies. It is a point of communication between the states and the federal government, and it provides pertinent information on the Medicaid program to states and Medicaid agencies.

The National Association of State Medicaid Directors was established in 1979 as an affiliate of the American Public Human Services Association. The Department has been a member since SFY 2004.

Membership provides the Department with informational and program resources which far exceed the annual costs.

The National Association of Medicaid Directors conducts trainings via conference calls and/or webinars on specific aspects of federal policy or regulations. The cost is included in the membership.
