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REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 9:16-c, I, authorize the Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) to transfer funds in and among classes within an accounting unit in the amount of \$89,000 for better use of appropriated federal funds, effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor & Council approval through March 31, 2019. 100% Federal funds.

EXPLANATION

In 1986, the Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) Trust Fund was created by Congress to address petroleum released from federally regulated underground storage tanks (USTs). DES is delegated by the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to: 1) oversee cleanups of petroleum releases by responsible parties, 2) enforce cleanups by recalcitrant parties, 3) pay for cleanups at sites where the owner or operator is unknown or unable to respond, or which require emergency actions, and 4) conduct inspections and other release prevention activities. Since the 1990s, DES has received a biennial grant of approximately \$1,420,000 and has typically used these monies to pay for personnel expenses addressing delegated responsibilities.

The transferred funds will be used for the personnel salaries listed below working in the petroleum contaminated site management program providing services in support of this program. Staff retirements and associated movement of staff to other positions not funded under this account resulted in underutilization of the Class 10 appropriation during the grant period. Current vacancies in fulltime positions funded under this account have necessitated reassignment of these duties to staff funded under other accounts. The requested transfer of funding from Class 10 to Class 59 will allow DES to fully utilize the current grant prior to its expiration and support cleanup of New Hampshire's LUST sites.

DES is requesting transfer of funding as follows:

Class 059 – Temp Full Time - \$89,000 is budgeted for transfers of existing positions' time from other DES organizational units to administer the LUST program. The funds will not be used for new positions, but are available in support of expending the grant funds by the March 31, 2019 expiration date. These funds will be used to supplant funding of the following positions, which are currently budgeted:
