REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Bureau of Human Resource Management to make a **retroactive** one-time payment from State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2017 funds to Jonathan Alexander, Teacher Assistant, Division for Children Youth and Families in the amount of \$1,981.25. This payment is to compensate the employee for wages that were not paid for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2016. The funds to be paid will be sixty-seven percent (67%) General Funds and thirty-three percent (33%) Federal. Funds are available in the following accounts as follows:

EXPLANATION

This request is made retroactively because Mr. Alexander was due compensation in State Fiscal Year 2016 that was not paid. The administrative error was not discovered until State Fiscal Year 2017.
