Explanation

The Wildlife Heritage Foundation of New Hampshire was established to enhance through private financial support the critical conservation programs of Fish and Game. As a New Hampshire nonprofit corporation, recognized as a 501(c)(3) public charity by the Internal Revenue Service, the Foundation was designated as an official nonprofit partner of the Department by the Fish and Game Commission under authority granted through RSA 206:33-c at their August 20, 2008 meeting.

A grant of \$48,622.56 is being provided by the Foundation for an addition to Barry Conservation Camp's dining hall. This project began a year ago and while efforts were made to keep the timeline on schedule, we were unable to secure a contractor during the previous fiscal year. The project is poised to move forward as soon as possible.


