Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Justice to enter into a subgrant with the NH Coalition Against and Domestic and Sexual Violence (vendor no. 155510-B001) in the amount of \$263,793, from the US Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women, Sexual Assault Support Program, for the purpose of providing services for victims of sexual assault in New Hampshire, from the period of Governor and Council approval through July 31, 2016. This is 100% Federal Funding.

Funding is available in account #02-20-201510-5301 (Job # 20SAS14A) entitled "Sexual Assault Support Program."

EXPLANATION

The Sexual Assault Services (SASP) grant program is a formula grant program from the US Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women and will be awarded to New Hampshire on an annual basis. These funds are the first federal funding stream solely dedicated to the provision of direct intervention and related assistance for victims of sexual assault.

The majority of these funds will be a pass through to the NH Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence (NHCADSV) as a subgrant. NHCADSV will in turn pass this funding through to twelve member agencies that will provide services to sexual assault victims on statewide basis. The purpose of the funding is the establishment of programs designed to address the lack of available direct intervention and related assistance services and the unique aspects of sexual assault trauma from which victims must heal. Services may include intervention, advocacy, support services, and related assistance to adult, youth and child victims of sexual assault.

These projects are funded one hundred percent (100%) by federal dollars. In the event that Federal Funds are no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support this program.
