EXPLANATION


This property consists of an unoccupied home on .39 acres of land located at the corner of Greely Street and Pembroke Road, adjacent to the State Military Reservation (SMR) in Concord. Our plan is to raze the building and extend the existing fence line further away from our buildings on the SMR property in order to meet current anti-terrorism/force protection setback distances. This purchase will also help us ensure that the protected habitat of the endangered Karner Blue Butterflies remains undisturbed due to their close proximity to the SMR.

Pursuant to New Hampshire law, RSA 4:29, I am providing the City of Concord with the necessary written notice that the State of New Hampshire - Adjutant General's Department is planning to purchase the property located at 34 Pembroke Road, Concord, New Hampshire and noted on the City of Concord Tax Map #116-4-4. The property sits on the corner of Greeley Street and Pembroke Road, adjacent to the State Military Reservation Property (SMR). 
