REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 261:97-c, <u>Use of Funds</u>, authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, New Hampshire State Library to award a Conservation Number Plate (Moose Plate) Grant to Rockingham County (VC #17468), Brentwood, NH in the amount of \$10,000 for the conservation treatment, digitization, and microfilming of a collection of historical ledgers containing Almshouse, Jail and Hospital Resident and Prisoner information dating back to the mid-19th century effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval through December 31, 2020. 100% Other Funds (Agency Income)

Funding is available in account, Conservation Plate Fund, as follows:

EXPLANATION

The Conservation Number Plate Fund is used to promote the use and conservation of cultural resources in New Hampshire and to preserve the cultural heritage that belongs to all New Hampshire citizens by providing for the preservation of publicly owned historic properties.

This project aims to preserve a collection of one-of-a-kind ledgers that are essential to the history of Rockingham County. These ledgers contain records of the Rockingham County Nursing Home, including vital records, "inmate" registers, admission and discharge lists, and more. The Nursing Home originally opened in 1868 as an Almshouse for poor and elderly county residents. Many of the inmates, or residents, worked at the County Farm as well. Later, in 1935, the Almshouse expanded and converted to Mitchell Memorial Hospital, Rockingham's first county hospital. The records to be preserved contain invaluable historical information of great interest to county residents, historians, and family researchers. By preserving, digitizing and microfilming these documents, Rockingham County will assure that future generations will have access to these historic records.

This agreement between the State of New Hampshire, Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, New Hampshire State Library (hereinafter "State Library") and Rockingham County, NH (hereinafter "Grantee") is to witness receipt of funds subject to the following conditions.

- 1. FUNDING PERIOD: State of New Hampshire Fiscal Year 2019/2020
- 2. OBLIGATION OF THE GRANTEE
 - 2.1.1. The Grantee agrees to accept \$10,000.00 and apply the funds to the project entitled Conservation Treatment and Digitization and Microfilming of Historical Ledgers containing Almshouse, Jail and Hospital Resident and Prisoner Information as described in the Grantee's FY 2019/20 Moose License Plate Conservation Grant application and budget. In the performance of this grant agreement the Grantee is in all respects an independent contractor and is neither an agent nor employee of the State.
 - 2.1.2. The Grantee agrees to abide by the limitations, conditions and procedures outlined herein and to perform grant activities as outlined in its grant application and project budget. If appropriated funds for this grant program are reduced or terminated (including a reduction by the NH Conservation License Plate Advisory Committee), all payments under this grant may cease. That determination rests within the sole discretion of the Commissioner of Natural and Cultural Resources.
- 3. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: Funding credit must appear in all programs, publicity, and promotional materials. The following wording is suggested.

"This preservation project has been made possible through funds received from the sale of the New Hampshire Moose Conservation License Plate and administered by the New Hampshire State Library, a division of the New Hampshire Department of Natural and Cultural Resources."

- 4. PAYMENT: Payment will be made upon the acceptance of this grant agreement in the amount of ninety percent (90%) and in the amount of ten percent (10%) upon the acceptance of final grant reports.
- 5. FINAL GRANT REPORTS: The Grantee agrees to submit final narrative and financial reports on a form provided by the State Library by December 31, 2020. Failure to submit final reports will render the Grantee ineligible for future Conservation License Plate Grant funding within the NH Department of Natural and Cultural Resources.
- 6. SOVERIGN IMMUNITY: No provision of this contract is to be deemed a waiver of sovereign immunity by the State of New Hampshire.

CERTIFICATE OF COVERAGE

The New Hampshire Public Risk Management Exchange (Primex³) is organized under the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, Chapter 5-B, Pooled Risk Management Programs. In accordance with those statutes, its Trust Agreement and bylaws, Primex³ is authorized to provide pooled risk management programs established for the benefit of political subdivisions in the State of New Hampshire.

The limit shown may have been reduced by claims paid on behalf of the member. General Liability coverage is limited to Coverage A (Personal Injury Liability) and Coverage B (Property Damage Liability) only, Coverage's C (Public Officials Errors and Omissions), D (Unfair Employment Practices), E (Employee Benefit Liability) and F (Educator's Legal Liability Claims-Made Coverage) are excluded from this provision of coverage.
