REQUESTED ACTION

The Office of Energy and Planning (OEP) respectfully requests authorization to **RETROACTIVELY** amend Governor and Executive Council item #14, approved on June 19, 2013, by extending the performance period of the FEMA Cooperative Technical Partners Program (CTP), Risk MAP activities, from September 14, 2013 to March 14, 2014, upon Governor and Executive Council approval. . No additional funding is involved in this time extension request. 100% Federal Funds (FEMA – Department of Homeland Security).

EXPLANATION

This request is **RETROACTIVE** due to OEP receiving documentation of the grant extension from FEMA on September 5, 2013.

This grant extension will allow OEP to continue to provide outreach and ordinance assistance to local communities in Strafford and Rockingham Counties where the FEMA-designated floodplains are being revised.

Due to FEMA delays in the floodplain map production schedule for these counties, OEP was not able to initiate its work on compliance/map adoption activities on schedule. It is anticipated that a six month extension until March 14, 2014 will be sufficient for OEP to carry out its work with these communities.

In the event that Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support this program.

EXPLANATION

Since 2002, the Office of Energy and Planning (OEP) has been responsible for administering New Hampshire's Map Modernization Program. Each year, FEMA invites state coordinating offices and other approved partners to apply for competitive funds to assist with its planned mapping initiatives for the year. OEP applied for and was subsequently awarded this grant on September 14, 2012. These funds will be used to support activities related to FEMA's map revisions in New Hampshire, specifically in the counties of Coos, Carroll, and Rockingham. OEP and UNH Complex Systems Research Center are both Cooperating Technical Partners with FEMA and were successful in jointly applying for this grant to work with communities on activities related to the map revision process, including compliance reviews of every community's floodplain ordinance, technical assistance to communities on the local, map adoption process and the development of datasets that will ultimately improve floodplain management and reduce flood risk across the state.

OEP did not anticipate at the time the FY12/13 budget was developed that it would receive these funds, and is therefore requesting that these funds be added to its budget now.

Funds are requested for the following purposes:

Class 041 - Audit Set-Aside

To cover 0.1% of the award for audit set-aside

Class 103 - Contracts for Operational Services

To provide mapping support to NH communities undergoing map revisions and the development of datasets to assist in local floodplain management.

Additional Indirect Costs and Fringe Benefits have not been budgeted in this request as the amount previously budgeted is sufficient to cover all indirect and fringe benefit costs associated with these funds.

In the event that the Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support these programs.
