**EXECUTIVE ORDER 2012-2**

**An Order Amending Executive Order 2006-11**

**WHEREAS**, the Interagency Council on Homelessness was established by Executive Order 2006-11; and

**WHEREAS**, this Executive Order amends Executive Order 2006-11;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN H. LYNCH**, Governor of the State of New Hampshire, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by Part II, Article 41 of the New Hampshire Constitution, do hereby order, effective immediately, as follows:

1. Paragraph a of Executive Order 2006-11 is amended to read as follows:

The Interagency Council on Homelessness (ICH) shall be comprised of up to 25 members, appointed by the Governor, including the following representation:

- New Hampshire Legislature;
- Commissioner of Health and Human Services or designee;
- One member of the New Hampshire Local Welfare Administrators Association nominated by the Association;
- Administrator of the Bureau of Homeless and Housing Services or designee;
- Director of the Veteran's Administration Medical Center in Manchester or designee;
- Administrator of the Bureau of Behavioral Health Services or designee;
- Commissioner of the Department of Corrections or designee;
- Department of Health and Human Services designee representing alcohol and drug abuse prevention, treatment and recovery;
- Director of the NH Housing Finance Authority or designee;
- Governor or designee;
- Commissioner of the Department of Education or designee;
- Two members from housing assistance service agencies, including representation from organizations that serve minority and resettlement populations;
- One member from Housing Action New Hampshire nominated by that organization;
- One member from an interfaith-based organization;

- One Director from a HRSA-funded Healthcare of the Homeless program;
  - One member from the New Hampshire Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence nominated by the Coalition;
  - Two representatives from charitable foundations; and
  - Two representatives from New Hampshire businesses.
2. Paragraph b of Executive Order 2006-11 is amended to allow that members representing state government may serve as long as they hold their designated positions in state government.
  3. Paragraph e of Executive Order 2006-11 is amended to reflect that the Office of Homeless, Housing and Transportation Services of the Department of Health and Human Services is now the Bureau of Homeless and Housing Services.
  4. Executive Order 2006-11 shall in all other respects continue in force and effect as originally issued on December 21, 2006.
