REQUESTED ACTION

- 1) Authorization is requested for the Department of Resources and Economic Development, Division of Forests and Lands to budget and expend \$16,000 from USDA Forest Service Consolidated Grants for the purpose of funding a projected deficit in the benefits class of the Urban Forestry Assistance Fund, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval through June 30, 2017. 100% Federal Funds
- 2) Authorization is requested for the Department of Resources and Economic Development, Division of Forests and Lands to accept and expend a USDA Forest Service Diversity Internship Grant in the amount of \$20,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval through September 30, 2017. 100% Federal Funds

EXPLANATION

The Division of Forests and Lands Urban and Community Forestry Program provides education and technical assistance to individuals and communities state-wide regarding the management and maintenance of street trees and community forests. This program is supported by grants received from the USDA Forest Service, Cooperative Forestry Assistance Program. A portion of the grant funds are used to support the Community Forestry Specialist position within the Division of Forests and Lands.

The purpose of this request is to:

- 1) Budget additional funds needed to cover a deficit in the benefits class line of the Urban Forestry Assistance Fund (3547). This deficit resulted when the former Community Forestry Specialist, whose benefit classification was individual, was replaced by an employee requiring family benefit coverage.
- 2) Accept and expend a \$20,000 USDA Forest Service Diversity Internship Grant awarded to the Division of Forests and Lands to provide technical assistance to communities, conduct community tree inventories and deliver urban forestry education programs. A portion of the grant will also be used to conduct Universal Access Trail Building workshops at the Urban Forestry Center in Portsmouth.

The total amount of grant funds available for Urban Forestry Assistance is \$305,632. This amount represents grant funds from 3 federal grants, i.e. Grant # 13-DG-11420004-254 in the amount of \$20,000, Grant # 14-DG-11420004-162 in the amount of \$142,665; and Grant # 15-DG-11420004-200 in the amount of \$142,967.

The original budget for FY 2017 is \$167,978. The requested additional amount of \$36,000 brings the overall FY 2017 budget to \$203,978.


