EXPLANATION

The USFSNA Evaluation Monitoring Program is a competitive RFP designed to allow States to compete for funds to perform projects that will protect the long term health of the local forests. Grant #077 was awarded to develop a field insectary capable of producing predator beetles to control hemlock woolly adelgid in NH. Grant #078 was awarded to investigate the white pine blister rust outbreak discovered on immune cultivars statewide.

These federal funds have been approved as the Department of Resources and Economic Development, Payment Grants #13-DG-11420004-077 and #13-DG-11420004-078

The following appropriations are requested for Fiscal Year 2014:

Class 030 Equipment \$1,000, for the purchase of a chainsaw to work insectary site

Class 040 Indirect Cost \$1,568, related to increased federal funds

Class 041 Audit Fund Set Aside \$336, related to increased federal funds

Class 049 Rental of State Owned Property \$9,220, to house the infested wood inside quarantine area

Class 050 Personnel Services-Temp \$7,300, to support one existing seasonal field technician

Class 060 Benefits \$566, amount related to increased temp labor

Class 070 Instate travel \$5,000, to fund the increase in fuel and vehicle costs

Class072 Grants-Federal \$8,610, to fund lab work subcontracted to Cornell University and fund the removal of trees at the insectary site

In the event that Federal Funds are no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to continue the support of this program.
