#### **REQUESTED ACTION**

Approve the request to transfer NH Department of Environmental Services Wetlands Bureau (NHDES) permit #2017-00695 to the new owner, Brianna Stephens Revocable Trust, to perform work on Lake Winnipesaukee in Tuftonboro as outlined below. Approve the request to extend said permit for a period of five years to allow the completion of the work authorized, in accordance with the requirements of RSA 482-A:3. The permit was originally issued to the Flint Family Revocable Trust, and previously approved by the Governor and Executive Council on June 7, 2017, Item #111.

Dredge 60 cubic yards from 1,244 square feet of lakebed to restore water depth in the approach to, and slips within, a 29 ft x 32 ft two-slip boathouse on an average of 145 feet of frontage along Lake Winnipesaukee in Tuftonboro.

The NHDES imposed the following conditions as part of this approval:

- 1. All work shall be in accordance with plans by Folsom Design Group dated February 20, 2017, and received by DES on March 13, 2017.
- All development activities associated with this project shall be conducted in compliance with applicable requirements of RSA 483-B and N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Env-Wq 1400 during and after construction.
- 3. This permit does not authorize the removal of trees or saplings within the waterfront buffer that would result in a tree and sapling point score below the minimum required per RSA 483-B:9, V, (a)(2)(D)(iv).
- 4. Work authorized shall be carried out such that there are no discharges in or to spawning or nursery areas during spawning seasons. Impacts to such areas shall be avoided or minimized to the maximum extent practicable during all other times of the year.
- 5. Work shall be carried out in a time and manner to avoid disturbances to migratory waterfowl breeding and nesting areas.
- 6. Appropriate turbidity controls shall be installed prior to construction, shall be maintained during construction such that no turbidity escapes the immediate dredge area and shall remain until suspended particles have settled and water at the work site has returned to normal clarity.
- 7. All dredged material shall be placed outside of the areas subject to RSA 482-A. Any spoil material deposited within 250 feet of any surface water shall comply with RSA-483-B.

- 8. The contractor responsible for completion of the work shall use techniques described in the New Hampshire Stormwater Manual, Volume 3, Erosion and Sediment Controls During Construction (December 2008).
- 9. Discharge from dewatering of dredged materials shall be completely contained within the area of containment established by the required turbidity controls.
- 10. The owner understands and accepts the risk that if this facility requires dredging to maintain a minimum slip depth of 3 feet more frequently than once every 6 years, or is shown to have an adverse impact on abutting frontages, it shall be subject to removal.
- 11. This facility is permitted with the condition that future maintenance dredging, if needed, shall not be permitted more frequently than once every 6 years, and that a new permit shall be required for each dredge activity.

#### **EXPLANATION**

The NHDES approved this project on March 22, 2022. The NHDES supported its decision with the following findings:

- 1. This permit transfer is issued in accordance with Rule Env-Wt 314.06.
- 2. Per Rule Env-Wt 314.05(b), the permittee submitted a written request to the department for an extension of permit #2017-00695 prior to the expiration of the permit.
- 3. Per Rule Env-Wt 314.05(c)(2), the submitted request included a statement, signed and certified in accordance with Env-Wt 311.11, that: the permit for which extension is sought has not been revoked or suspended without reinstatement; extension of the permit would not violate a condition of law or rule; the project is proceeding towards completion in accordance with plans and other documentation referenced by the permit; the applicant proposes reasonable mitigation measures to protect the public waters of the state from deterioration during the period of extension; and the wetland delineation is still valid pursuant to Env-Wt 406.01(b).
- 4. Per Rule Env-Wt 314.05(d), as specified in RSA 482-A:3, XIV-a(a), the department finds the permittee has submitted the request as specified in Env-Wt 314.05(b) and (c) and the mitigation measures proposed by the permittee are adequate to protect public waters from deterioration. The department therefore grants one extension of 5 additional years for permit #2017-00695.

Application file documents are being forwarded to the Governor and the Executive Council in connection with their consideration of this matter pursuant to RSA 482-A:3, II(a), as it is a major project in public waters of the state.

We respectfully request your approval of this item.





Maintenance dredging to remove sand which has deposited over the years. Total of dredge area equals 1,244 sq.ft. and a total of 60 cu. yds of sand. This will reestablish the three foot water depth for owner's boats.


The NH Natural Heritage database has been checked for records of rare species and exemplary natural communities near the area mapped below. The species considered include those listed as Threatened or Endangered by either the state of New Hampshire or the federal government. We currently have no recorded occurrences for sensitive species near this project area.


