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The seventeenth day of December, 2012, being the first Monday after the second Wednesday of December, before midday of said day, the College of Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States for the State of New Hampshire, having received official information that they had been duly chosen Electors as aforesaid, assembled at the Executive Council Chambers at the State House in Concord in said State.

William M.Gardner, Secretary of State, called the Electoral College to order, called the roll, and administered the oath of office to the Electors present.

Having elected a temporary organization through the election of C. Arthur Soucy as temporary president, the Electors unanimously elected as president James Demers and as secretary C. Arthur Soucy, as doorkeeper Joanne Dowdell and as teller Mary Rauh.

Upon motion of James Demers the College of Electors adopted the following *resolution*:

**RESOLVED:** Having received official information that we have been chosen Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States, we are now present in the Executive Council Chambers in the State House on this seventeenth day of December at ten o'clock a.m., and we severally accept the office and have organized by the choice of James Demers as our President and C. Arthur Soucy as our Secretary and we are now ready to proceed to the discharge of the duties of our office.

After a welcome by the Secretary of State, the Electors adopted the following *resolutions*:

**RESOLVED:** That the Electors now proceed to ballot for President of the United States.

This was done and the result announced as follows: Total votes cast - four (4) all of which were for **Barack Obama of Chicago, Illinois**, who was declared elected.

**RESOLVED:** That the Electors now proceed to ballot for Vice-President of the United States. This was done and the result announced as follows: Total votes cast - four (4) all of which were for **Joe Biden of Wilmington, Delaware**, who was declared elected.

The certificates and lists of the votes of the Electoral College for President and Vice-President of the United States were presented to the Electors for their signature.

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## Electoral College

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We, the undersigned, Electors of President and Vice-President of the United States of America for the term beginning on the twentieth day of January, 2013, being electors duly elected and qualified by and for the State of New Hampshire, as appears by the annexed certificate, having met and organized at the State House in Concord in said State in accordance with the Act of Congress approved February 3, 1887, and acts supplementary thereto, approved October 19, 1888, May 28, 1928, and June 4, 1934, being the thirteenth of said month, then and there proceeded to vote by ballot for such President by distinct ballots and for such Vice-President by distinct ballots.

We hereby certify that the following person received votes for President of the United States:

Barack Obama of Chicago, Illinois had four votes.

We hereby certify that the following person received votes for Vice-President of the United States:

Joe Biden of Wilmington, Delaware had four votes.


