Authorize the Department of Transportation to pay the Manchester Transit Authority (MTA), Vendor 154782, Manchester, NH, an amount not to exceed \$268,030.00, to provide half of the funds required to match Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grant funds for eligible revenue rolling stock to support Manchester Transit Authority effective upon Governor and Council approval and available until expended. 100% State Capital Funds.

EXPLANATION

The State Capital Budget (Ch. 15-220:1-XVI-A3 Public Transportation, Laws of 2015 and Ch. 17-228:1-XXII:A Aero, Rail, Transit, Laws of 2017) include funds to match grants from the FTA for vehicles, passenger amenities and facilities, and associated transit-related capital equipment. MTA will utilize FTA formula grants to fund 80% of the total cost of nine (9) replacement ADA accessible vehicles. State capital funds will provide one-half of the required match for eligible capital projects. The estimated project costs and detailed breakdown of funding sources is detailed in the following table:

State capital budget funds made available for this capital project shall not exceed \$268,030.00 and, pursuant to the provisions of the State capital budget, shall be reimbursed by the Department to MTA upon approval of Governor and Council and the submission of an invoice to the Department for eligible projects.

Doing so enables transit systems to operate at optimal safety and efficiency, thus providing the quality of service that riders have come to expect.
