REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with New England Signal Systems, Inc. (Vendor 174153) of Northwood, NH on the basis of a low bid of \$511,753.50 for conversion of permissive left turns to flashing yellow arrow signal configuration, from the date of Governor and Council approval through November 6, 2020, unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Federal Funds.

Funding to support this request are anticipated to be available in the following accounts in Fiscal Year 2020 and Fiscal Year 2021 upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds in the future budget, with the ability to adjust encumbrances through the Budget Office between State Fiscal Years if needed and justified:

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$25,587.68 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 5% of the contract amount.

EXPLANATION

This project is part of the State's Ten Year Transportation Improvement Plan under the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). This Contract comprises two projects as described below.

The Statewide 42424 project converts permissive left turns operating under a green ball signal indication to flashing yellow arrow left turns at fourteen state owned signalized intersections in Concord (2), Conway, Goffstown, Hooksett (2), Hudson, Kingston (2), Meredith, Portsmouth, Raymond, Seabrook, and Windham. This work will be accomplished by replacing the existing three section signal heads with

four section signal heads that include a flashing yellow arrow. Other signal improvements at the intersections include cabinet work, adding and replacing signing on the signal mast arm, and other updates as needed to initiate the flashing yellow arrow at each location.

The Tilton 29358 project proposed improvements at the intersection of US Route 3 and Silver Lake Road in Tilton include installation of a mast arm with flashing beacons directed at the three intersection approaches. Two sight distance easements were also purchased as part of this design to ensure no future sight distance encroachments.

The Statewide project is to improve safety and decrease crashes at signalized intersections with existing permissive green ball or "doghouse" indications and dedicated left turn lanes. The Tilton project intersection was subject of 2012 Road Safety Audit (RSA); 29 crashes from 2006-2010, with no fatal or incapacitating injuries. Project scope has reduced since RSA, as site conditions of the surrounding properties have substantially changed since that time.

The proposed contingency amount is 5% of the contract amount. This is due to working in close proximity to underground utilities at a few locations and for traffic control coordination at the different locations.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available and the bid reasonably conforms to the engineer's estimate in accordance with State procedure. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

This project funding is 90% (Highway Safety Improvement Program HSIP) utilizing Turnpike Toll Credits as the State's 10% match, effectively using 100% Federal Funds.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

DESCRIPTION: This Contract comprises two projects as described below.

STATEWIDE 42424: Converts permissive left turns operating under a green ball signal indication to flashing yellow arrow left turns at fourteen state owned signalized intersections in Concord (2), Conway, Goffstown, Hooksett (2), Hudson, Kingston (2), Meredith, Portsmouth, Raymond, Seabrook, and Windham. This work will be accomplished by replacing the existing three section signal heads with four section signal heads that include a flashing yellow arrow. Other signal improvements at the intersections include cabinet work, adding and replacing signing on the signal mast arm, and other updates as needed to initiate the flashing yellow arrow at each location.

<u>TILTON 29358</u>: Proposed improvements at the intersection of US Route 3 and Silver Lake Road in Tilton include installation of a mast arm with flashing beacons directed at the three intersection approaches. Two sight distance easements were also purchased as part of this design to ensure no future sight distance encroachments.

FEDERAL FUNDING:

STATEWIDE 42424 & TILTON 29358: 90% (HSIP) with anticipated utilization of Turnpike Toll Credits for the State's 10% match.

CONTINGENCY:

STATEWIDE 42424 & TILTON 29358: The proposed contingency amount is 5% of the contract amount. This is due to working in close proximity to underground utilities at a few locations and for traffic control coordination at the different locations.

PROJECT INITIATED:

STATEWIDE 42424: Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), systematic project.

TILTON 29358: Road Safety Audit (2012).

PROJECT EXPLANATION:

<u>STATEWIDE 42424:</u> To improve safety and decrease crashes at signalized intersections with existing permissive green ball or "doghouse" indications and dedicated left turn lanes.

<u>TILTON 29358</u>: Intersection was subject of 2012 Road Safety Audit (RSA); 29 crashes from 2006-2010, with no fatal or incapacitating injuries. Project scope has reduced since RSA, as site conditions of the surrounding properties have substantially changed since that time.

TRAFFIC IMPLICATION:

STATEWIDE 42424 & TILTON 29358: Lane and shoulder closures will be used to allow for the removal and installation of overhead signals. Uniformed officers will be required whenever temporary impacts to signal operations take place. All other work will be completed using short-term traffic control operations.
