EXPLANATION

This request is being made to accept \$79,676 of Child Welfare Services (CWS) Disaster Relief Funds that were allocated to New Hampshire through Public Law (P.L.) 116-20, Additional Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Act of 2019; Title IV-B, Subpart 1 of the Social Security Act. Specifically, this is to provide support for Grafton County, New Hampshire due to the natural disaster (flooding) that occurred there in July 2019. These funds will be used to support targeted Foster Care recruitment and retention activities and programs for Grafton County. These are allowable uses under Title IV-B, Subpart 1 and will go towards further supporting the families impacted in Grafton County and provide a stronger network of foster parents to serve the children and families in this area.

Funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Class 020 - Foster Care Recruitment and Retention Activities

Class 102 - Contracted support for Foster Care Recruitment and Retention Activities

Class 041 - Audit Fund Set Aside per State Requirements.

Area served: Statewide.

Source of Funds: 100% Federal

If Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support the program expenditures.
