

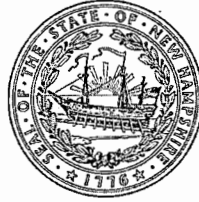

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Sheri L. Phillips, Position #9U565, Appropriation # 02-20-20-200510-2611-013-500132 as an Attorney, at a salary level of \$72,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or July 30, 2018, whichever is the latter.

EXPLANATION


Ms. Phillips is a resident of Stratham, New Hampshire and a member the New Hampshire Bar. She received her law degree from the University of New Hampshire School of Law, Concord, New Hampshire in 2003, and her Master of Science in Physical Therapy from Boston University, Boston, Massachusetts in 1987. Ms. Phillips worked as a law clerk for in both the New Hampshire Superior and New Hampshire Supreme Courts, and as a staff attorney at the New Hampshire Public Defender's Office in Stratham, New Hampshire. In view of Ms. Phillips' experience, I am requesting that she be appointed as an Attorney at a salary of \$72,000. She will be assigned to the Consumer Protection Bureau – Administrative Prosecution Unit. A copy of her resume is attached.

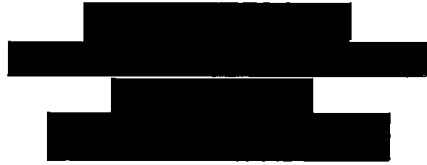
