

EXPLANATION

Amir Alic is currently a Gaming Audit Supervisor at the New Hampshire Lottery Commission. Today's business climate demands managers who can make decisions involving the best use of an organization's scarce resources under conditions that change rapidly. This course demonstrates the power of problem-solving insights and uses a cross-functional approach. Topics to be covered include strategic pricing using game theory, forecasting techniques and demand estimation, cost analysis, linear programming and optimization under various market structures. The Economic Analysis course will provide Amir with additional knowledge needed for his position as a Gaming Audit Supervisor and will help him understand basic economic concepts in order to recognize why individuals, businesses, governments, etc. make the financial decisions that they do. A specific government regulatory policy directly relating to the Gaming Audit Supervisor position is the limit placed on gaming by the State of NH. Taking this course will further his knowledge of the economic impact on gaming policies that policies like this have. The employee will be attending the course on his own personal time and will be responsible for payment of required books and other materials.

EDUCATION TUITION AGREEMENT

Agreement dated this 20 day of July 2016 by and through the New Hampshire Lottery Commission (hereinafter referred to the "State" and Amir Alic hereinafter referred to as the "Recipient").

The State and the Recipient do hereby mutually agree as follows:

1. The State shall pay to the named institution the sum of \$1,623.00, which monies shall be used for the purpose of enrolling the Recipient in: **Economic Analysis**, which course (s) is being offered by Plymouth State University and which course (s) shall commence on September 12, 2016 and terminate on November 20, 2016.
2. The Recipient shall complete and achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1.
3. Should the recipient fail to complete or achieve a grade of B or better in each course named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall pay to the State the sum set forth in paragraph 1, provided, however, that if more than one course is named in paragraph 1, the amount which shall be paid to the State shall be calculated on a pro rata basis.
4. Upon the satisfactory completion of the courses named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall continue to be an employee of the State in his/her current position (or in such other position, at equal or greater compensation, to which he/she may be assigned) for a period of 12 months.
5. Should the recipient breach any of the conditions set forth in the paragraphs above, the Recipient shall pay to the State a sum equal to all monies previously paid by the State for the Recipient pursuant to the Agreement, provided, however, that the Recipient shall receive a credit for each month in which he/she is employed by the State subsequent to the date upon which the named course (s) are satisfactorily completed, the value of said credit to be calculated on a pro rata basis.
6. The Recipient shall not raise any setoff or counterclaim against the State in any action brought by the State to collect any amount due under this agreement.
7. Should any amount be found to be due the State in any action brought against the Recipient pursuant to this Agreement, the State shall, in addition to said amount, be entitled to an award of costs and a reasonable amount in "attorney" fees.


