EXPLANATION

The NH Department of Health and Human Services, Medicaid Program, under Section 1202 of the Affordable Care Act, is required to increase primary care reimbursement to parity with Medicare for calendar years 2013 and 2014, including any submission's one year from the date of service within those calendar years. The Affordable Care Act implements Medicaid payment for primary care services furnished by certain physicians in calendar years 2013 and 2014 at rates not less than the Medicare rates in effect in those calendar years. This minimum payment level applies to specified primary care services furnished by a physician with a specialty designation of family medicine, general internal medicine, or pediatric medicine, and also applies to services paid through Medicaid managed care plans. It is a 100 percent federal matching rate for any increase in payment above the amounts that would be due for these services under the provisions of the State plan as of July 1, 2009. The rate increase is the difference between the enhanced rate and the 2009 NH fee for service rate.

Class 041 The funds will be used to pay audit fund set aside expense.

Class 101 The funds will be used to make the primary care reimbursement as referenced herein.

In response to the anticipated two-part question, "Can these funds be used to offset general funds?" and "What is the compelling reason for not offsetting general funds?" The Department offers the following information: These 100% federal cannot be used to offset general funds, as they are restricted to the activities referenced herein. Should the request be denied, the funds in question must be returned to the Federal Government and the State of New Hampshire will be out of compliance with Federal requirements.
