### Requested Action

Authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police (NHSP), to accept and expend \$82,038.00 of pass-through federal funds from the Department of Safety, Office of Highway Safety, entitled "New Hampshire State Police C.A.R. (Collision Analysis & Reconstruction) Equipment Grant" to purchase equipment to assist with completing documentation while investigating crashes. Effective upon Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2021. Funding Source: 100% Agency Income.

### Explanation

These funds from the Office of Highway Safety will enable the NHSP C.A.R. Unit to purchase cameras and accessories along with a crash data retrieval pro tool kit and cable package to assist with diagramming crash scenes in a timely, complete, and accurate manner. This equipment will allow the C.A.R. Unit to fully document and completely investigate crashes. This equipment will be used to obtain detailed quality photographs essential to accurately portray the scene exactly as it was immediately after the crash. This is anticipated to yield more solid prosecutions and increase the conviction rates by potentially 10%, over the previous year, for crash-related serious injuries or fatalities.

The funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Funds in class 030, Equipment, will be used to purchase 20 Nikon cameras with accessories, a crash data retrieval pro tool kit, and a crash data retrieval cable package.




