Requested Action

Pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Rule 316.13 (a) (5), the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, requests authorization to pay overtime in the amount of \$62,539.00 for permanent personnel from class 10 appropriations for positions that are vacant due to illness, extended leaves of absence, or pending recruitment at State Police Communications. The \$62,539.00 represents the estimate of additional funds needed for the pay periods covering February 15, 2019 through the end of SFY 2019. Effective upon Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2019. Funding Source: 49.9% General, 27.6% Turnpike, and 22.5% Highway Funds.

Explanation

The Department of Safety, Division of State Police, State Police Communications (Dispatch) requests a transfer from Class 10, Personnel Services, to Class 018, Overtime, in the amount of \$62,539.00, due to higher than expected overtime hours worked while conducting State Police Communications (Dispatch) during critical vacancies due to sickness, extended leaves of absence, or pending recruitments.

The New Hampshire State Police Communications Unit dispatches for seven Troops in addition to our Marine Patrol, Bureau of Liquor Enforcement, Office of the State Fire Marshal, the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources (DNCR), and Fish and Game. The unit is the after-hours provider for other state agencies such as the Bureau of Emergency Management, Attorney General's Office, and the Medical Examiner's Office and maintains electronic lines to the National Weather Service Alert System, Emergency Alert System (EAS), Seabrook and Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Facilities.

The center is also responsible for receiving all nationwide law enforcement electronic messages. This includes the data entry system for both the National Criminal Information Center (NCIC), and the National Law Enforcement Telecommunications System (NLETS). This also includes entering information from state and local agencies into the State Police On-Line Telecommunications System (SPOTS) and NLETS, including the NCIC State database for In-State Misdemeanor Warrants and Domestic Violence Petitions (DVP).

Currently, State Police Communications has four full time vacancies. The average recruitment-to-hire time has been roughly five to eight months, not including training prior to assuming any full time shifts.

The above requested action is to cover the expenses incurred for SFY 2019 and any additional expenditure for the remainder of SFY 2019, based on the number of full time vacancies, unanticipated illness, leave, and pending recruitment.

This request is made in accordance with applicable law. The A-29 form is attached to support this request.
