#### **EXPLANATION**

The Adjutant General's Department requests authorization to accept and expend additional Federal Funds in the amount of \$340,000.00 for the purpose of Recruiting and Retention Command for furniture purchases for two new store front Recruiting and Retention Offices in Nashua and Manchester, as well as replacement of existing furniture across the organization in all Recruiting and Retention offices in order to standardize the face of the New Hampshire National Guard and provide a professional and disciplined face to the New Hampshire National Guard.
