REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 4-C:35, the Office of Strategic Initiatives respectfully requests authorization to expend Governor’s Scholarship Program funds to participating New Hampshire post-secondary institutions in the amount of \$4,070,000.00, effective upon Governor and Council approval. 100% General Funds.

EXPLANATION

The Governor’s Scholarship Program is designed to provide financial assistance to eligible high school graduates or recent high school graduates to attend a post-secondary educational or training program of their choice within the state of New Hampshire. The program shall provide scholarships which a recipient shall apply to the tuition, fees, and direct costs of an education at a participating post-secondary institution.

Each participating post-secondary institution shall receive an allocation based on programs offered. Participating post-secondary institutions may be eligible for multiple allotments if they offer multiple eligible programs. Eligible programs mean an associate degree program, bachelor’s degree program, certificate program or career program.

The Office of Strategic Initiatives notified all New Hampshire post-secondary educational institutions and training programs of the Governor’s Scholarship Program; twenty-three post-secondary educational institutions and training programs responded, and met the eligibility requirements of the Governor’s Scholarship Program.



Funding allocations to participating post-secondary institutions shall be divided equally among all participating post-secondary institutions that offer an eligible program.

The Office of Strategic Initiatives has met with and engaged stakeholders in order to fairly allocate funding and ensure that the Governor's Scholarship Program is financially solvent.

These non-lapsing funds will be distributed during the 2018-2019 academic year.
