## REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a VI, the Department of Safety, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, requests authorization to accept and expend Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) and Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) grant funds in the amount of \$496,296.00 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for the implementation of sustained pre-disaster natural hazard mitigation. Effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approvals through June 30, 2023. Funding Source: 100% Federal Funds.

## **EXPLANATION**

The Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) Grant program provides funding to sub-grantees for cost-effective hazard mitigation activities that complement a comprehensive mitigation program. In Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2020, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) replaced PDM with the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) Grant program, providing funds to states that, in turn, provide sub-grants or contracts for a

variety of mitigation activities, including planning and the implementation of projects identified through the evaluation of natural hazards.

The State of New Hampshire solicits applications statewide. Notification of the availability of BRIC funds is made to every community by e-mail and by letters sent to the chief elected official of each community. The State of New Hampshire submits all applications received for program funding to FEMA for their final approval. Applications that are determined to be cost effective and program eligible are then funded 75% by FEMA; not every application submitted is determined to be program eligible. The sub-grantee will provide and document the 25% program match requirements.

At the time the State of New Hampshire FY 22/23 budget was being developed, it was not anticipated that the State would receive this level of funding.

Funds are to be budgeted and transferred as follows:

- Class 018 Overtime To be used to pay overtime costs incurred supporting the grant program, including attending non-business hour meetings with local communities.
- Class 040 Indirect Cost Represents the indirect cost associated amount for this request.
- Class 041 Audit Fund Set Aside Represents the audit fund set aside associated amount for this request
- Class 059 Temp Full-Time Funds existing full time temporary positions supporting PDM and BRIC grant administration, working to pass through funds to eligible local projects and activities. This will allow HSEM to match the time worked on these grant programs to the appropriate grant program funding.
- Class 060 Benefits To pay the benefits associated with the existing full time temporary positions.
- Class 072 Grants Federal To fund BRIC grant program projects to local communities.

There are no General funds required with this request. In the event that Federal funds are no longer available, General funds and/or Highway funds will not be requested to support this program.
