REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of the Commissioner to make a **retroactive** one-time payment from State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2022 funds to Adnela Alic, Program Specialist at the HHS: Commissioner's Office in the amount of \$15,188.21. This payment is to compensate the employee for wages that were not paid for State Fiscal Years 2020 and 2021. The funds to be paid will be (100%) Federal funds. EXPLANATION

This is the first of five remaining requests, all to be presented to Governor & Council on June 1, 2022. This request is made retroactively because the Division of Public Health Services received permission from the Division of Personnel to apply retroactive temporary reclassifications to select staff who worked out of classification as part of the COVID-19 response. While discussions about the temporary reclassifications began as early as March 2021, they were not approved until August 2021. Relevant information about the affected employees, the dates of the

Ms. Alic served as the Traveling Monitoring Unit Lead, Contact Tracing Branch Director, & Deputy Operations Chief from February 3, 2020 through March 10, 2022.

This request is for the portion of the retroactive payment from February 3, 2020 through June 30, 2021. Approval of this Request will allow payment of overdue wages to Ms. Alic.
