EXPLANATION

The Department is requesting to (i) accept supplemental Designated State Health Programs (DSHP) funds as allowed by the New Hampshire's Section 1115 Research and Demonstration Transformation Waiver in the Bureau of Mental Health Services, (ii) transfer general funds from the Bureau of Mental Health Services to the Bureau of Drug and Alcohol Services and (iii) transfer additional general funds from the Bureau of Mental Health Services as well as from the Bureau for Children's Behavioral Health to the Bureau of Drug and Alcohol in order to properly reflect where the DSHP federal revenue will be earned and the general funds to the Governor's Commission accounting unit where DSHP federal revenue was budgeted, but will not be earned.

On January 5, 2016, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approved New Hampshire's Section 1115 Research and Demonstration Transformation Waiver enabling the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) to access new federal funding for the purpose of strengthening and expanding capacity for the State's behavioral health system, allowing the State to access up to a total of \$150 million over the next five years (approximately \$30 million per year).

As part of the New Hampshire Building Capacity for Transformation 1115 Waiver, CMS has granted authority for DHHS to receive federal matching funds for costs not otherwise matched through the Designated State Health Programs (DSHP). During the budget preparation for the 2018/19 biennium the Department estimated the amounts of DSHP to be earned based on

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trending and forecasts for expenses up to the annualized CAP set by The Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). There were changes made during this biennium by CMS to allow for supplemental program areas to earn DSHP revenue. The Department seeks to accept supplemental DSHP revenue not budgeted in the Bureau of Mental Health Services (i). The Department makes this request to properly reflect the areas where the DSHP revenue was earned for reimbursement.

The Department sought and was granted an amendment under its 1115 Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment waiver to substitute DSHP qualified programs that would replace at an equivalent dollar amount for programs the Department would otherwise claim DSHP on The request permits the accurate accounting for where the substitute DSHP revenue should reside. This, along with the carry forward of prior year DSHP revenue that would not be recognized due to meeting the 2018 calendar year annual CAP set by CMS, caused a federal revenue (DSHP) shortfall in AU 3382 Governor's Commission. The Department requests actions (ii) and (iii) outlined above to address the revenue reduction in DSHP funds budgeted, but will not be earned. In addition to this Fiscal Item, DHHS will be sending a memo to the Department of Administrative Services to request a write down of the Federal funds in the amount of \$3,114,542, and corresponding expenditures, as required by RSA 124:14, to bring the total Governor's Commission account into balance.

The following is the information specifically required when transfers are requested, in accordance with the Budget Officer's instructional memorandum dated April 17, 1985, to support the above requested actions:

- A) Justification: As noted above this request is to accept additional DSHP revenue in the Bureau of Mental Health Services and to transfer general funds to the Bureau of Drug & Alcohol Services.
- B) Does this transfer involve continuing programs or one-time projects? This transfer involves continuing programs.
- C) Is this transfer required to maintain existing program levels or will it increase the program level?
 This transfer is required to maintain existing program levels.
- D) Cite any requirements which make this program mandatory.

 The programs of the Department are mandated by various state and federal laws.
- E) Identify the source of funds on all accounts listed on this transfer.

- F) Will there be any effect on revenue if this transfer is not approved? Yes, federal revenue earned will not be budgeted in the correct accounting units. In addition, the Governor's Commission accounting unit (3382) will show a revenue shortfall.
- G) Are funds expected to lapse if this transfer is not approved? Yes, the general funds would lapse at the end of FY19.

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H) Are personnel services involved?
 No positions are being transferred as a result of this request.

Area served: Statewide

In the event that federal funds become no longer available, general funds will not be requested to support the program expenditures.
