REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI, authorize the Department of Justice to accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$137,616 from the U.S Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs, Project Safe Neighborhood Program for the purpose of funding local police agencies conducting hot spot patrols throughout the State from the date of the Fiscal Committee of the General Court and Governor and Council approvals through June 30, 2019. 100% Federal Funds

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EXPLANATION

The New Hampshire Department of Justice is seeking approval to accept and expend a grant award received from the Federal Bureau of Justice Assistance, under the Project Safe Neighborhoods Program (PSN). These funds were not previously budgeted because the grant became a formula grant after the budget was presented. Because PSN is now a formula grant, funds will be budgeted in the future.

The Department of Justice will subgrant PSN funds to local police departments in the state experiencing high levels of violent and opioid-related crimes. The Department of Justice will act as the fiscal agent for the State of New Hampshire Project Safe Neighborhoods Task Force (Task Force) which is coordinated by the U.S. Attorney General's Office and comprised of members from federal, state and local law enforcement as well as community partners.

Police departments will apply for funds to cover overtime and related costs for police officers to conduct targeted hot spot patrols in areas that are known for high levels of crime. The Task Force will review the applications and make recommendations for funding. The Department of Justice will manage and monitor the grant funds.

Officers actively involved in designated hot spots will allow for a community driven response. Available data and research support the effectiveness of hot spot patrols. For example, the "Koper Curve" theory claims that 10–16 minutes of hot spot policing reduces crime for approximately 2 hours afterward in that particular area. Christopher S. Koper, an associate professor at George Mason University and Senior Fellow at the University's Center for Evidence-Based Crime Policy, theorized that, in most communities, more than 50 percent of crimes occur in less than 5 percent of a particular area. These areas are referred to as hot spots.

Koper discovered that using an intermittent method of patrolling hot spots for 10-16 minutes every two hours significantly reduced crime rates. Rather than using a steady patrol schedule, using a random drive-by patrol method is the key. Koper's research showed that the likelihood of criminal activity within 30 minutes of a patrol drive-by was 15 percent. When random police patrols lasting 10-16 minutes were used, the likelihood of criminal activity dropped to 4 percent.

In addition, the "Koper Curve" method provides for an efficient use of a patrol officers' time and allows the officers to be more visible, which improves officer-community relationships.¹

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Hot spot areas will be monitored and measured as follows:

- Data compiled on number of violent crimes before hot spot patrol intervention vs. number of violent crimes after hot spot patrol intervention.
- Proactive Officer initiated activity from before the intervention vs. during intervention.
- Statistical significance testing to determine whether increased officer activity can be contributed to the reduction of violent crime.
