#### **JUSTIFICATION**

This request is Retroactive. The reason it is late is two-fold. First, Mr. Adorno was made aware that the AC5250 Managerial Accounting course was to be offered this summer later than normal. Second, given Mr. Adorno's anticipated summer workload, he did not believe it would be possible to take these two courses during the summer semester. After speaking with his bureau administrator and supervisor, who are both strongly supportive of enrollment in these particular courses as soon as possible to enhance his value and his ability to provide better technical assistance to public water systems, changes were made in his schedule to allow him to do so. Both Mr. Adorno and his supervisors will consult sooner in the future so as to avoid retroactive requests.

As the Environmental Program Manager at the Drinking and Groundwater Bureau at the Department of Environmental Services, Mr. Adorno has the pleasure of working with communities to increase their Capacity Development. Capacity Development is a process for water systems to acquire and maintain adequate technical, managerial, and financial capacity in order to ensure that communities have the capability to consistently provide safe drinking water to the public. This technical assistance requires for Mr. Adorno to stay current with many of the aspects in line with the New England College's Master of Business Administration (MBA) degree. Mr. Adorno is just a few credits short of obtaining his degree which will be completed by the Fall of 2019.

Mr. Adorno is required to sign a contract, which obligates him to work for the State for 6 months after satisfactory completion of each class. The agreement does require him to obtain a passing grade. If he does not comply with the terms of the contract, he will be liable for returning the amount paid. The program is directly related to his responsibilities as the Environmental Program Manager for the Drinking Water and Groundwater Bureau and the technical assistance that he provides to communities around the State of New Hampshire.

This tuition assistance has been a very successful program of the department and has resulted in many benefits to the State. The cost is minimal when compared to the cost of salary and benefits. The courses being taken directly relate to the individual and his job accountabilities, and we encourage our staff to further develop their skills so they can keep up with the latest developments in their work. We have encouraged Mr. Adorno to take these courses as part of our professional development plan.

# THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE EDUCATIONAL TUITION AGREEMENT

Agreement dated this <u>13</u> day of <u>May</u> 20 <u>19</u> by and through the Department of Environmental Services (hereinafter referred to as the "State) and Luis Adorno hereinafter referred to as the "Recipient").

The State and the Recipient do hereby mutually agree as follows:

1. The State shall pay to the named institution the sum of <u>\$4,760.00</u>, which monies shall be used for the purpose of enrolling the Recipient in:

- 2. The Recipient shall complete and achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1.
- 3. Should the Recipient fail to complete and achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1, the amount which shall be paid to the State shall be calculated on a pro rata basis.
- 4. Upon the satisfactory completion of the courses named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall continue in the employ of the State in his/her current position (or in such other position, at equal or greater compensation, to which he/she may be assigned) for a period of Six (6) Months for each class.
- 5. The Recipient shall work in any area of the State to which he/she may be assigned, provided that such assignment will not constitute a severe hardship to said Recipient.
- 6. Should the Recipient breach any of the conditions set forth in paragraphs 4 and 5, the Recipient shall pay to the State a sum equal to all monies previously paid by the State for the Recipient pursuant to the Agreement, provided, however, that the Recipient shall receive a credit for each month in which he/she is employed by the State subsequent to the date upon which the named course(s) are satisfactorily completed, the value of said credit to be calculated on a pro rata basis.
- 7. The Recipient shall not raise any setoff or counterclaim against the State in any action brought by the State to collect any amount due under this agreement.

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8. Should any amount be found to be due the State in any action brought against the Recipient pursuant to this Agreement, the State shall, in addition to said amount, be entitled to an award of costs and a reasonable amount in "attorney" fees.
