

REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 21-I:80, I(b), authorize the Department of Resources and Economic Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, Cannon Mountain to make a **SOLE SOURCE** and **RETROACTIVE** payment to Royal Electric (VC #154900), Woodsville, NH in the amount of \$4,705 for running additional power to the Eagle Cliff and Zoomer Triple Lifts and a snowmaking junction house at Cannon Mountain Ski Area on November 30, 2012.
100% Capital Fund

EXPLANATION

Royal Electric was previously awarded a contract (August 8, 2012, Item #72) to provide electrical installation of snowmaking fan gun cabling and terminals, and cable to three minor building structures at Cannon Mountain Ski Area. Royal Electric expanded the electrical installation to allow Cannon to incorporate increased snowmaking capacity on all of Lower Cannon trail, the TossUp Terrain Park, and the top of Gary's trail. While working on the snowmaking addition, Royal Electric was asked to provide power to three additional mid-mountain buildings to prevent freeze ups in the snowmaking junction houses and add additional snowmaking. This associated work was originally planned to be a separate project, but it was determined by Cannon that this remaining portion of the overall project would be far more cost effective and timely given the trench was open and Royal Electric was already on site while on-site. Rather than requesting to amend the existing contract which has expired, the Department is requesting sole source and retroactive approval to make payment to Royal Electric for this additional work. The invoice was received in late January.
