**REQUESTED ACTION**

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with Nott's Excavating, Inc. (Vendor 251945) of White River Junction, VT on the basis of a low bid of \$1,237,473.00 for stabilization of approximately 400 feet of failed roadway embankment in Plainfield, from the date of Governor and Council approval through June 19, 2020, unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Betterment Funds.

Funds to support this request are anticipated to be available in the following account in FY 2020 upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds in the future operating budget.

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$123,747.30 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 10% of the contract amount.

**EXPLANATION**

This emergency repair project is part of the State's Ten Year Transportation Improvement Plan under the Betterment – Stand Alone Projects and Contingency Funds. The project is located just north of the intersection of NH Route 12A and Beauty Hill Road/River Road in Plainfield, and involves stabilization of approximately 400 feet of failed roadway embankment between NH Route 12A and the Connecticut River, as well as reconstruction of NH Route 12A where the failure encroached into the existing roadway.

This cover letter is being expedited for the Council's review without the contract documents, which are lacking only the final signatures. The slope failure occurred on April 21 and necessitated the closure of

the southbound lane of NH 12A. Alternating one-way traffic has been maintained since then and the unstable slope has continued to slowly slide, potentially jeopardizing the remaining northbound lane as well.

The proposed work will repair and stabilize the slope failure by placing stone fill, beginning at the toe of the slope and extending to the top of bank. Stone fill will be covered with humus and seeded with native grass. Additional improvements include clearing vegetation, and full box reconstruction of a section of NH Route 12A. Ancillary work includes underdrain installation and ditchline improvements along the east side of the road as well as drainage and guardrail replacement, and site specific landscape installation.

The proposed contingency amount is 10% of the contract amount. This is to account for the risk of overruns associated with the proposed work is high due to the instability of the existing ground and continued changing field conditions, as well as the aggressive construction timeline.


The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract will be reviewed by the Attorney General as to form and execution once submitted, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available and the bid reasonably conforms to the engineer's estimate in accordance with State procedure. Copies of the fully executed contract will be on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

This project funding is 100% Betterment – Stand Alone Projects and Contingency Funds.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

no cents (\$1,237,473.00) mentioned in the original proposal, which proposal and prices named,  
together with The State of New Hampshire Standard Specifications approved and adopted in 2016  
and the Special Provisions accompanying the proposal and attached hereto, are made a part of this  
Contract and accepted as such, and also the plans of the (roadway stabilization and reconstruction)  
prepared by The Department of Transportation and also agreed by each party as being a part  
hereof, the said (roadway stabilization and reconstruction) being situated as follows:

This project involves stabilization of approximately 400 feet of failed roadway embankment  
between NH Route 12A and the Connecticut River, as well as reconstruction of NH Route 12A.

The Contractor further covenants and agrees that all of the said materials shall be furnished  
and delivered and all of said labor shall be done and performed in every respect to the satisfaction  
and approval of the Commissioner, on or before June 19, 2020.

The Contractor hereby further agrees to receive the following prices as full compensation  
for furnishing all the materials and labor, which may be required in the prosecution in all respects  
to complete said Contract to the satisfaction of the Commissioner.

The successful Bidder, at the time of the execution of the contract, must deposit with the Commissioner security in the sum equal to 100 percent of the amount of the contract award. The form of bond shall be that provided by the Department and the surety shall be acceptable to the Commissioner.

## **SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET**

**DESCRIPTION:** The project is located just north of the intersection of NH Route 12A and Beauty Hill Road/River Road in Plainfield, and involves stabilization of approximately 400 feet of failed roadway embankment between NH Route 12A and the Connecticut River, as well as reconstruction of NH Route 12A where the failure encroached into the existing roadway.

**FEDERAL FUNDING:** 0% (100% Betterment – Stand Alone Projects and Contingency Funds)

**CONTINGENCY:** The proposed contingency amount is 10% of the contract amount. The risk of overruns associated with the proposed work is high due to the instability of the existing ground and continued changing field conditions, as well as the aggressive construction timeline.

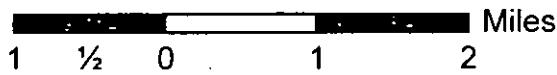
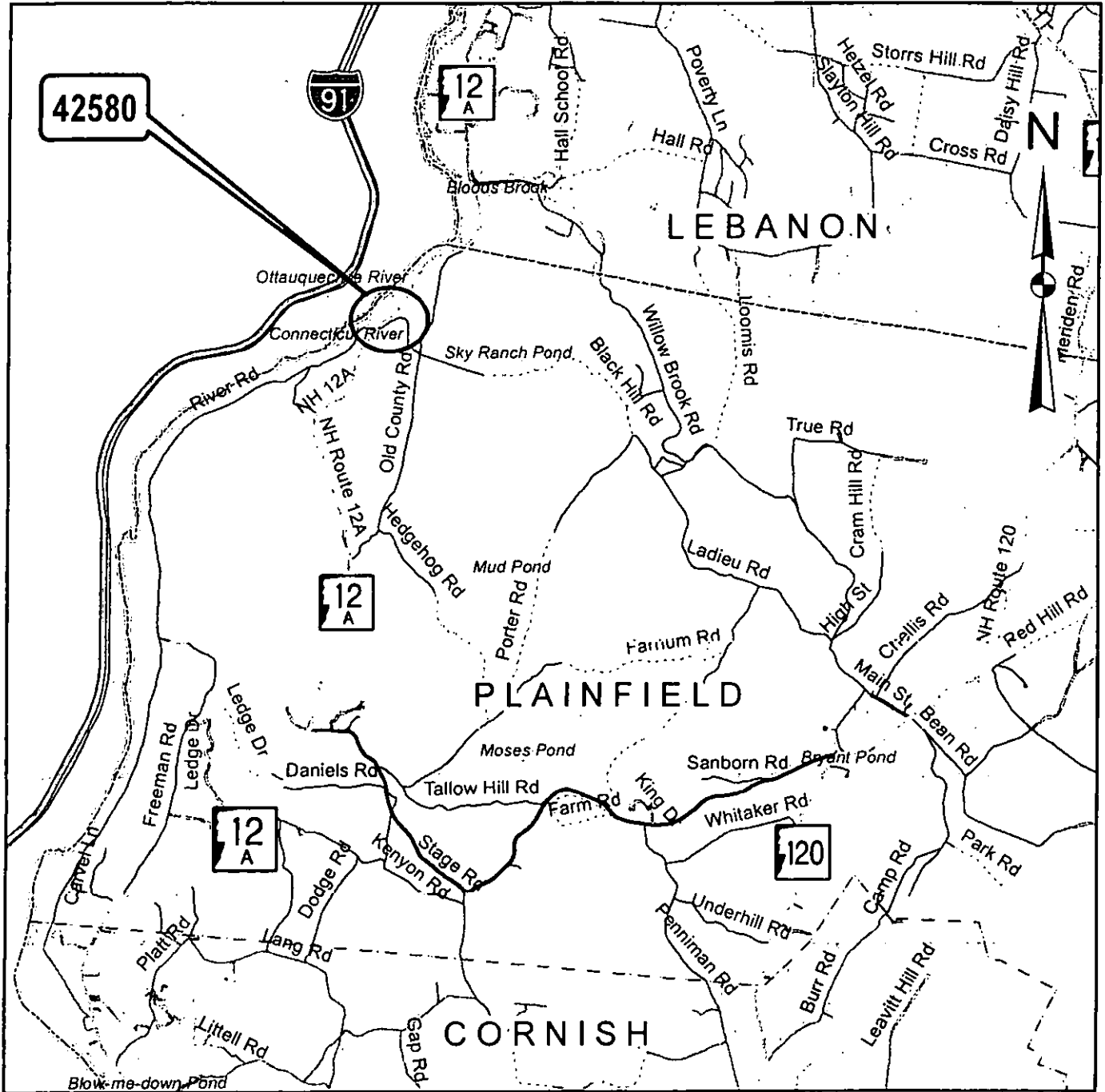
**PROJECT INITIATED:** This project was initiated as an emergency response to intense rainfall and related flooding on April 21, 2019.

**PROJECT EXPLANATION:** The proposed work will repair and stabilize the slope failure by placing stone fill, beginning at the toe of the slope and extending to the top of bank. Stone fill will be covered with humus and seeded with native grass. Additional improvements include clearing vegetation, and full box reconstruction of a section of NH Route 12A. Ancillary work includes underdrain installation and ditchline improvements along the east side of the road as well as drainage and guardrail replacement, and site specific landscape installation.

**TRAFFIC IMPLICATION:** One lane, alternating two-way traffic will be maintained during the length of the contract to the maximum extent practical, without jeopardizing public safety.
