## REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with Pike Industries, Inc. of Belmont, NH (Vendor 177300) on the basis of a single bid of \$4,385,331.00 for resurfacing of approximately 61 miles in District II in Grafton and Sullivan Counties, from the date of Governor and Council approval through September 29, 2017 unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 8% Highway Funds, 92% Other Funds (41% Betterment and 51% Agency Income).

## **EXPLANATION**

This project is included in the State's Ten Year Transportation Improvement Plan and part of the annual Maintenance District resurfacing program with additional funding for paving through SB 367 Road Toll Increase. This project involves pavement resurfacing of approximately 61 miles of state highways in the District Two region. The resurfacing will preserve and extend the life of the highway riding surface and protect the subsurface base course materials. All of the proposed work will remain within the right-ofway.

Although there was only one bid received and the bid costs exceeded the Department's estimate by 7%, this bid is felt to be reasonable for the work involved. The bid received was reasonably consistent with other resurfacing bids. Readvertising this project would result, in our opinion, in higher prices and prevent the completion of the work in a timely manner. The Department considers it to be in the best interest of the State to accept this bid to accomplish these needed repairs.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available and the bid reasonably conforms to the engineer's estimate in accordance with State procedures. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

## SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

**DESCRIPTION:** This project involves resurfacing under Betterment FY 2018 program and SB-367 FY 2018 and FY 2016 programs. The Betterment program (16162F) includes 6 sections totaling 28 miles of roadways including sections along NH 4A (Grafton-Enfield), NH 10 (Newport-Croydon), North Thetford Rd (Lyme), NH 120 (Cornish-Plainfield), NH 10 (Lyme-Orford), and NH 10 (Piermont). The SB-367 program (40702) includes 9 sections totaling 33 miles of roadways including sections along Unity Springs Rd (Lempster-Unity), Main/Stinson Lake Rd (Rumney-Ellsworth), NH 25A (Orford), NH 25A (Wentworth), NH 112 (Bath-Easton), NH 135 (Bath-Monroe), NH 135 (Haverhill-Bath), North Dochester Rd (Wenthworth), and Sand Pond Rd (Lempster).

**FEDERAL FUNDING:** 0% (44.8% FY 2018 Betterment, 26.4% FY 2016 SB-367, and 28.8% FY 2018 SB-367).


**CONTINGENCY:** None.

**PROJECT INITIATED:** State's 10-Year Transportation Improvement Program under Pavement Strategies: Tier 2 Maintenance, Tier 3-4 Preservation, Tier 3-4 Maintenance, Tier 3-4 Roughness.

**PROJECT EXPLANATION:** These roadways are located throughout District 2 and serve various functions. These pavements are in fair to poor condition. The intent of this project is to maintain and improve the riding surface and to extend the life of the existing roadways. All of the proposed work will remain within the right-of-way.

TRAFFIC IMPLICATIONS: Minimal traffic implications are anticipated. Alternating one-way traffic will be allowed only on roads with pavement widths less than forty-eight feet. Normal traffic patterns will be re-established prior to the beginning of non-work hours. No work will be permitted from May 26 to May 29, June 30 to July 4 and from September 1 to September 4, 2017. No work on sections 16220, NH 4A (Grafton-Enfield); 17210, NH 10 (Lyme-Orford); 17211, NH 10 (Piermont); 17212, NH 25A (Orford); 17213, NH 25A (Wentworth); and 17221, NH 135 (Haverhill-Bath) from July 6 to July 9 due to the Prouty Bike Race. Work on section 17206, NH 10 (Newport-Croydon) shall not begin before July 1 and shall be finished prior to August 18, 2016.
