Requested Action

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police to accept the donation of a portable light tower with a value of approximately \$8,000.00 from the Defense Logistics Agency to be used by the Division of State Police. Effective upon Governor and Council approval.

Explanation

The Department of Safety has been given the opportunity to acquire the above mentioned equipment through the 1033 Program property. The 1033 Program is the transfer of surplus military equipment from the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) to Law Enforcement. Every state has a 1033 Program which was created to reutilize surplus military equipment that would otherwise be destroyed.

State Police will use the portable light tower at its gun range located in New Hampton. The firearms program includes low-light/night time shooting, but currently State Police does not have the means to light the range for teaching classes for these programs. The portable light tower is mounted to a trailer and is powered by a generator. This piece of equipment will enhance the firearms training program for State Police.
