# **REQUESTED ACTION**

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Charles O. Bucca to Position #9U648 (Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-2611-500132) as an Attorney at a salary level of \$95,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or June 17, 2022, whichever is later.

# **EXPLANATION**

Mr. Bucca, a Concord resident, earned his Bachelor of Arts at Hartwick College in 1994, and his Juris Doctor from Albany Law School of Union University in 1999. For the first six months after being admitted to the New York Bar, he worked part-time as a prosecutor at the Greene County District Attorney's Office in Catskill, New York, and part-time at his father's law office before taking a position as an Associate at Gerstenzang, O'Hern, Hickey & Gerstenzang in Albany, New York (2000 to 2001). Since 2002, he has been a career criminal prosecutor. He first held a variety of positions within the Greene County District Attorney's Office—including Assistant District Attorney (2002 to 2011), Chief Assistant District Attorney (2011 to 2014), and Acting District Attorney (2014). He next moved to the Saratoga County District Attorney's Office in Ballston Spa, New York, where he served as an Assistant District Attorney in the General Felony Bureau (2015 to 2021). Most recently, he has been an Assistant United States Attorney in the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Oklahoma since 2021. In light of Mr. Bucca's experience, I am requesting he be appointed as an Attorney at a salary of \$95,000. He will be assigned to the Criminal Justice Bureau. A copy of his resume is attached.

RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General,

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subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.

I am very pleased to offer Mr. Bucca's appointment as an Attorney at the abovereferenced salary for your approval and respectfully urge your favorable consideration. Thank you.
