REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with Pike Industries, Inc. (Vendor 177300) of Belmont, NH on the basis of a low bid of \$514,067.55 for permanent pavement repairs to damage due to October 29, 2017 storm event in the District 1 area, from the date of Governor and Council approval through October 12, 2018 unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Other Funds - FEMA.

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$25,703.38 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 5% of the contract amount.

EXPLANATION

This project work is the result of 4 flooding events that occurred on October 29, 2017, with a major disaster declaration decreed on January 2, 2018. This project will rehabilitate 4 non-contiguous Tier 2 roadway sections located within District 1, including:

STM77059 (US 3 CARROLL)

Segment location is US 3 in Carroll (Twin Mountain) between mile markers (MM) 147.0 and MM 147.2, and consists of an approximately 200' full width pavement rehabilitation area located, adjacent and west of Carroll Br. No. 149/028. Work includes excavation and grading for pavement, drainage and guardrail.

STM77060 (US 302 HARTS LOCATION)

Segment location is US 302 in Harts Location between MM 48.4 and MM 48.8; Harts Location Br. No. 136/097 is located within the segment. Work at this location includes the placement of a 1" 1100' full width asphalt overlay.

STM77061 (US 302 HARTS LOCATION)

Segment location is US 302 in Harts Location between MM 48.0 and MM 48.2, adjacent and east of Harts Location Br. No. 127/096. Work at this location includes the excavation, fine-grading and paving of a damaged shoulder section approximately 110' in length and 8' in width.

STM77063 (US 302 BARTLETT)

Segment location is US 302 in Bartlett between MM 61.9 and MM 62.6. Work includes a 2" inlay of existing asphalt or gravel repair areas, and the placement of a full width, 2250' length 1" overlay.

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate the existing pavement at the locations described above to a service level comparable to that prior to the October 29, 2017 storm. The need is to preserve US 3 and US 302 asset serviceability.


The proposed contingency amount is 5% of the contract amount. The project was not surveyed and therefore items have been quantified based on field observations, as-built plans, and aerial photos only. Field adjustments may be required due to varying field conditions.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available and the bid reasonably conforms to the engineer's estimate in accordance with State procedure. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

This project funding is 80% federal emergency relief funds with 20% state match.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

DESCRIPTION: This project will rehabilitate 4 non-contiguous Tier 2 roadway sections located within District 1, including:

STM77059 (US 3 CARROLL)

Segment location is US 3 in Carroll (Twin Mountain) between mile markers (MM) 147.0 and MM 147.2, and consists of an approximately 200' full width pavement rehabilitation area located, adjacent and west of Carroll Br. No. 149/028. Works includes excavation and grading for pavement, pavement, drainage and guardrail.

STM77060 (US 302 HARTS LOCATION)

Segment location is US 302 in Harts Location between MM 48.4 and MM 48.8; Harts Location Br. No. 136/097 is located within the segment. Work at this location includes the placement of a 1" 1100' full width asphalt overlay.

STM77061 (US 302 HARTS LOCATION)

Segment location is US 302 in Harts Location between MM 48.0 and MM 48.2, adjacent and east of Harts Location Br. No. 127/096. Work at this location includes the excavation, fine-grading and paving of a damaged shoulder section approximately 110' in length and 8' in width.

STM77063 (US 302 BARTLETT)

Segment location is US 302 in Bartlett between MM 61.9 and MM 62.6. Work includes a 2" inlay of existing asphalt or gravel repair areas, and the placement of a full width, 2250' length 1" overlay.

FEDERAL FUNDING: 80% (FHWA ER) utilizing Turnpike Toll credits as the State's 20% match

CONTINGENCY: The proposed contingency amount is 5% of the contract amount. The project was not surveyed and therefore items have been quantified based on field observations, as-built plans, and aerial photos only. Field adjustments may be required due to varying field conditions.

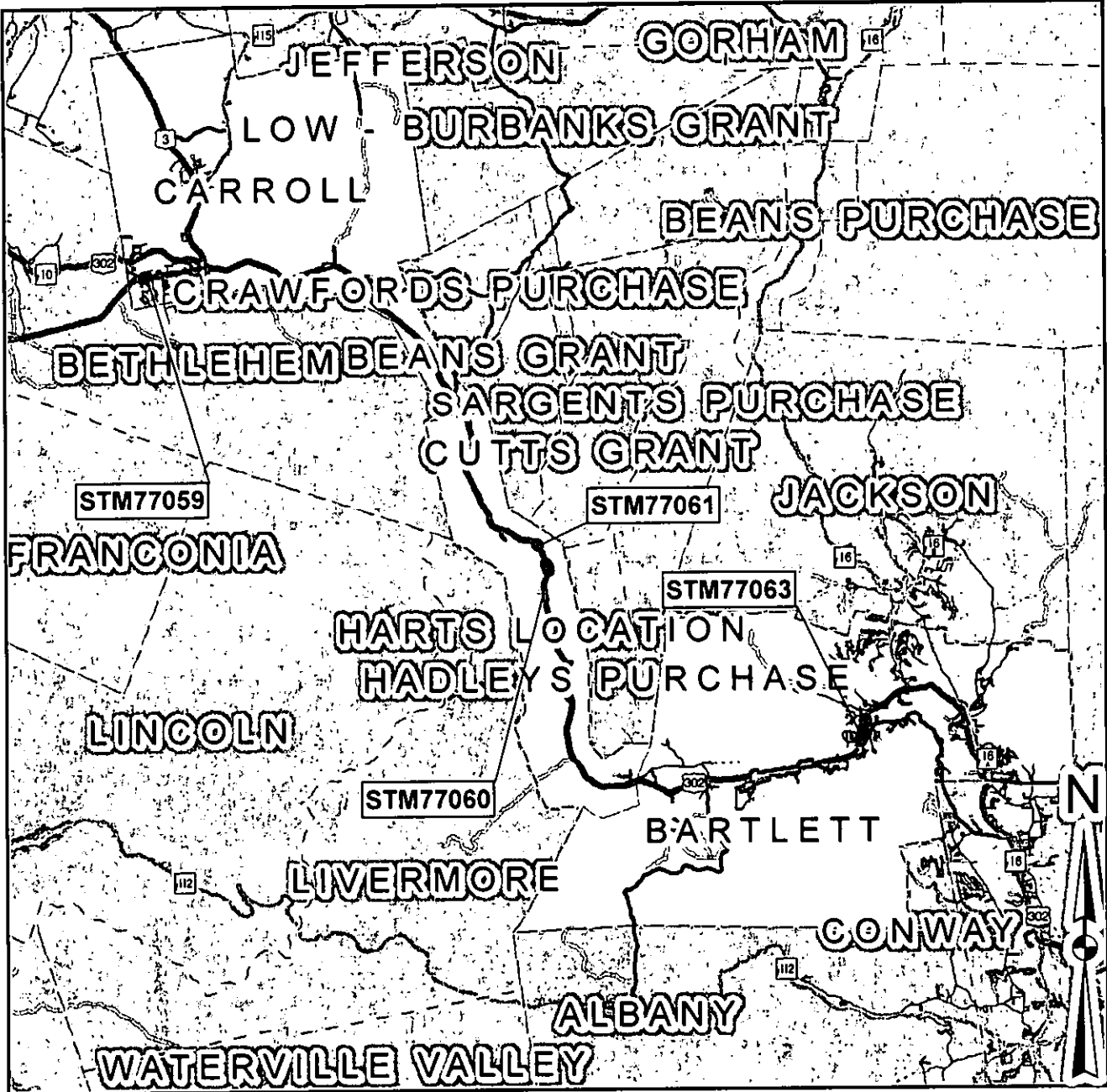
PROJECT INITIATED: Emergency Repair Project initiated from an October 29, 2017 storm event with a major disaster declaration declared on January 2, 2018.

PROJECT EXPLANATION: The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate the existing pavement at the locations described above to a service level comparable to that prior to the October 29, 2017 storm. The need is to preserve US 3 and US 302 asset serviceability.

TRAFFIC IMPLICATION: This project will use single lane, alternating two-way traffic where necessary during construction hours, supplemented with flaggers or uniformed officers with vehicle. Traffic will return to two lanes during non-construction hours.

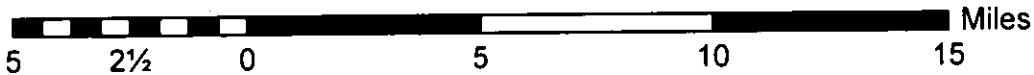

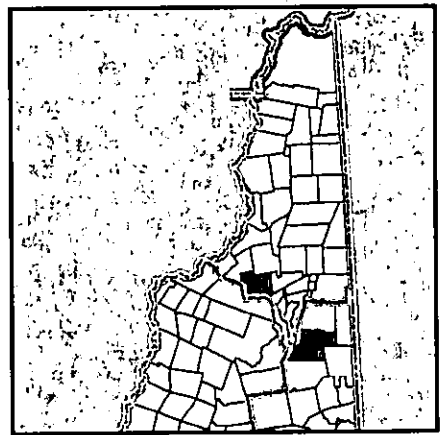

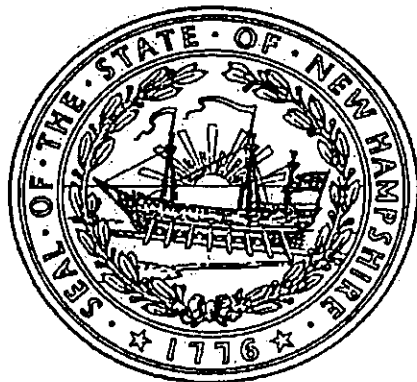
