REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to reappoint Lisa M. Ms. English will be occupying a position for a full five-year term effective December 11, 2017 to December 11, 2022 upon Governor and Executive Council approval.


EXPLANATION

Ms. English is a resident of Weare, New Hampshire and a member of the New Hampshire Bar. She received her law degree from Boston College School of Law in 2004. She worked at the law firm of Goodwin Proctor LLP, the Boston College Law School Legal Assistance Bureau and the New England School of Law as an Adjunct Professor prior to joining this office. Ms. English joined our Office in 2010 and was appointed as an Assistant Attorney General in 2011. She was appointed the Director of Charitable Trusts in 2014. In 2015, she was appointed as a Senior Assistant Attorney General and Bureau Chief of the Civil Bureau, filling out a term ending December 11, 2017. This reappointment will give her another full five year term. Her salary as a Senior Assistant Attorney General is currently \$88,920 and will remain the same. I plan to continue her assignment to the Civil Bureau. A copy of her resume is attached.

2001 Laws of NH Chapter 158 amended RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) to provide that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.

I am very pleased to offer Ms. English's reappointment as an Assistant Attorney General at the above-referenced salary for your approval and respectfully urge your favorable consideration. Thank you.
