REQUESTED ACTION

- 1. Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI, authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health Services, to accept and expend funds from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to fund the New Hampshire Integrated Viral Hepatitis Surveillance and Prevention program in the amount of \$337,090 effective July 1, 2022 upon approval by the Fiscal Committee and Governor and Executive Council through June 30, 2023 and further authorize the funds to be allocated as follows. 100% Federal Funds.
- Contingent upon the approval of Requested Action #1, pursuant to RSA 124:15, authorize the Department
 of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health Services to create a full-time temporary position,
 9T3196, for the purpose of supporting the Integrated Viral Hepatitis Surveillance and Prevention Program
 effective July 1, 2022 upon approval by the Fiscal Committee and Governor and Executive Council through
 June 30, 2023. 100% Federal Funds.

EXPLANATION

This request is being made to accept additional grant funds available for the New Hampshire Integrated Viral Hepatitis Surveillance and Prevention Program. In recognition of the high burden of viral hepatitis and the need for increased public health resources, the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) have awarded additional grant funds to further develop integrated viral hepatitis surveillance and prevention programs. These additional resources are intended to support viral hepatitis outbreak planning, detection, and response; surveillance for viral hepatitis infection; increased comprehensive viral hepatitis infection reporting; development of a jurisdictional viral hepatitis elimination plan; and linkage to infectious disease care and treatment services for persons diagnosed with viral hepatitis. These activities require the establishment of a dedicated Viral Hepatitis Epidemiologist to efficiently and accurately analyze, interpret, and report on infectious disease trends to inform the Division of Public Health Services decision-making and support viral hepatitis surveillance, prevention, and care efforts. This Viral Hepatitis Epidemiologist position is necessary in order to provide the highest level of awareness

related to the impact of viral hepatitis infection among persons living in NH, increase capacity to monitor changing disease patterns and initiate effective response, and support the development and completion of priority projects.

The funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Class 041	These funds will be used to pay for audit fund set aside per state requirement.
Class 042	These funds will be used to pay for post-retirement benefits.
Class 059	These funds will be used to support a full time temporary Viral Hepatitis Epidemiologist, Program Specialist IV, Labor Grade 25, position# 9T3196. This position will develop and integrate viral hepatitis surveillance and prevention programs and will conduct and coordinate epidemiological investigations.
Class 060	These funds will be used to pay for benefits associated with the new position above.
Class 102	These funds will be used to contract for viral hepatitis elimination services by developing a 5-year tristate Viral Hepatitis Elimination Plan targeting prevention, diagnosis and treatment services.

The following information is provided in accordance with the comptroller's instructional memorandum dated September 21, 1981:

- 1. List of personnel involved: One full-time temporary Vital Hepatitis Epidemiologist/ Program Specialist IV (9T3196).
- 2. Nature, Need, and Duration: The position will provide for the increased needs caused by required activities under the Integrated Viral Hepatitis grant. The position will be needed for the duration of this funding.
- 3. Relationship to existing agency programs: This new funding will sit within the NH Department of Health & Human Services, Division of Public Health Services, Bureau of Infectious Disease Control, Infectious Disease Surveillance System, and will support the evolving needs of the Bureau of Infectious Disease Control as a whole.
- 4. Has a similar program been requested of the legislature and denied? No
- 5. Why wasn't funding included in the agency's budget request? At the time of budget submission it was not known that this additional funding would be available.
- 6. Can portions of the grant funds be utilized? All grant dollars are being used for this request.
- 7. Estimate the funds required to continue this position: Through June 30, 2023, estimated salary and benefits are as follows:

Program Specialist IV FY 2023
\$114,235

In response to the anticipated two-part question, "Can these funds be used to offset General Funds?" and "What is the compelling reason for not offsetting General Funds?" the Division offers the following information: The funds are provided for a specified purpose by the CDC as defined in the Notice of Grant Award and cannot be used to offset general funds. These funds will not change the program eligibility levels. No new program will be established with the acceptance of these funds.

Area served: Statewide

Source of Funds: These funds are 100% Federal from the Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

This Program Specialist IV/Viral Hepatitis Epidemiologist position is being established to develop and integrate viral hepatitis surveillance and prevention programs in the Bureau of Infectious Disease Control. It will be funded through the Integrated Viral Hepatitis and Prevention Funding for Health Departments Grant. The role will conduct and coordinate case, cluster/outbreak, and epidemiological investigations following approved protocols, analyze and interpret surveillance data using statistical software, and will develop, review, and present reports on infectious disease trends, investigations, and outbreaks. Further, this position will make recommendations for the planning and development of disease surveillance, prevention, and care program activities and provide data for the Bureau of Infectious Disease Control. Decision-making and collaboration with federal and state officials and agencies, healthcare providers, public and private laboratories, and other partners will also be part of the role's purview to ensure timely, accurate, and compliant disease reporting.

This position number will be inactive until you receive funding approval from the Fiscal Committee per RSA 124:15.


