Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to grant a salary increase to Allison B. Greenstein, as an Assistant Attorney General (Position 9U357, Appropriation #02-20-20-201010-2623-013-500132), from a salary level of \$66,437.50 to a salary level of \$70,000 **retroactive** to July 1, 2019 upon Governor and Executive Council approval.

EXPLANATION

In accordance with the 2001 N.H. Laws Chapter 158, Section 101, and 2018 N.H. Laws Chapter 162, Section 14, this request seeks your approval to grant a salary increase for Assistant Attorney General Allison B. Greenstein. This item is **retroactive** because funds in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 biennium budget were not available to submit this request prior to July 1, 2019.


Ms. Greenstein is a resident of Manchester. She received her law degree from Boston University School of Law in 2013. Prior to joining the Department of Justice, Ms. Greenstein was an associate attorney at Sumner F. Kalman in Plaistow from 2013 through 2017. She joined the Department of Justice in September 2017 as an attorney in the Transportation and Construction Bureau and was appointed as an Assistant Attorney General on October 26, 2018. Ms. Greenstein's salary will increase by \$3,562.50, from \$66,437.50 to \$70,000. I will continue her assignment as Assistant Attorney General in the Transportation and Construction Bureau.

RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.
