#### **REQUESTED ACTION**

#### **EXPLANATION**

The purpose of this request is to budget additional funds in certain classes for the Winnipesaukee River Basin (WRB) program. The WRB is a regional wastewater treatment system covering 10 communities within the Lakes region. The system operates a wastewater treatment plant in Franklin that provides the 10 surrounding communities with wastewater treatment and other water pollution control measures. Increases in class 18—Overtime and class 23—Heat/ Electricity are now needed because there were unexpected equipment repairs requiring significant staff overtime and higher than normal utility bills from the harsh winter that used more of these classes funding that originally budgeted. These additional funds will allow WRB to meet its financial obligations for the balance of the fiscal year.
