EXPLANATION


Ms. Ramsey is a Kensington resident and a member of the New Hampshire and Texas Bars. She earned her undergraduate degree from the University of Texas at Austin in 1987, and her Juris Doctor at the University of Texas School of Law in 1991. She was as an associate attorney, and later a partner, at Minton, Burton, Foster and Collins, P.C., in Austin, Texas, from 1991 to 2002. She was a partner at Cantey and Hangar, L.L.P., from 2002 to 2006. In 2006, she co-founded Foster Ramsey, P.C., where she practiced until 2018. In addition to her legal practice, Ms. Ramsey was a Director of the Texas Legal Protection Plan from 2006 to 2011. She moved to New Hampshire in 2018 and briefly operated a solo law practice in Exeter before joining *sklawyers, pllc*, in February 2019. She came to the Department of Justice in September 2019 as a litigation attorney in the Civil Bureau. Her salary will increase by \$3,000, from \$84,000 to \$87,000. I will continue her assignment in the Civil Bureau. A copy of her resume is attached.

RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.
