Requested Action

Pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Rule 316.13 (a) (5), the Department of Safety. Division of Fire Safety. Fire Marshal's Office requests authorization to pay overtime in the amount of \$75,000.00 for permanent personnel from class 10 appropriations for positions that are vacant due to the lack of being able to find skilled applicants. The \$75,000.00 represents the estimate of additional funds needed for the remainder of SFY 2020. Effective upon Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2020. Funding Source: 52.5% Fire Fund, 47.5% General Fund.

Explanation

The Department of Safety, Division of Fire Safety, Fire Marshal's Office requests an overtime transfer for actual expenditures not to exceed \$75,000.00. The requested overtime expenditure from Class 10, Personal Services account, represent payments made to permanent personnel for overtime hours worked during the recent Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. The Division has reassigned staff resources to assist in the statewide response which requires working extended hours.

The Department of Safety, Division of Fire Safety, Fire Marshal's Office spent \$101,429.01 in SFY 2018 and \$145,331.95 in SFY2019 in overtime expenses. In SFY 2020, the Division has spent \$127,500.28 to date.

The above requested action is to cover the expenses incurred in SFY 2020 and any additional expenditure for the remainder of SFY 2020, through June 30, 2020, based on the duration of the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). A total of 4 full-time positions have been vacant during SFY 2020.

This request is made in accordance with applicable law. The A-29 form is attached to support this request.
