REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, Division of the Arts, to award an Arts in Health grant to Symphony New Hampshire (VC #160048), Nashua, NH in the amount of \$5,250 to support music programming for populations in hospice and incarcerated youth effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval through June 30, 2021, 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available in account, Federal Arts Partnership Grant, as follows:

EXPLANATION

Arts in Health grants are awarded to nonprofit organizations responding to the Arts Council's recognition that arts and culture facilitate the physical, cognitive, and socio-emotional aspects of individual healing, and that when applied to public health, promote healthy environments, and policies in communities by promoting empathy, awareness, and social cohesion through shared narrative and aesthetic experiences. Grant categories and deadlines are advertised through the Arts' website, social media, and electronic newsletters.

At a recent meeting, the NH State Art Councilors unanimously voted to accept the Arts Council's Arts in Health Review Panel's recommendations for the grants based on its funding priority ranking within a competitive review. The five-member peer panel considered 6 criteria to arrive at a consensus ranking for each application. Each panelist is advised, both individually and collectively, of their obligation to disclose any conflict of interest and themselves from assessment if a conflict is present. The evaluative criteria range from the administrative capacity of the organization, quality of programming, participant benefit, community support, accessibility and equity.

Symphony New Hampshire already received an Arts Council NH CARES Act grant in the amount of \$7,500 in Fiscal Year 2021. The cumulative total with this grant is over the \$10,000 threshold therefore requires Governor and Executive Council approval.

The Attorney General's office has reviewed and approved the grant agreement as to form, substance and execution.

NEW HAMPSHIRE STATE COUNCIL ON THE ARTS GRANT AGREEMENT

This agreement between the State of New Hampshire, New Hampshire State Council on the Arts (hereinafter "Council") and Symphony NH (hereinafter "Grantee") is to witness receipt of funds subject to the following conditions:

1. GRANT PERIOD: FY2021

2. OBLIGATIONS OF THE GRANTEE:

- The Grantec agrees to accept \$5,250.00 and apply it to the program(s) described in the grant application and approved budget for To support Symphony NH's Arts in Health for underserved populations in hospice and incarcerated youth. In the performance of this grant agreement, the Grantee is in all respects an independent contractor and is neither an agent nor employee of the State.
- Funding credit including Council logo must appear in all programs, publicity, and promotional materials. The following wording and Council logo should be used:



Symphony NH is supported in part by a grant from the New Hampshire State Council on the Arts & the National Endowment for the Arts.

- The Grantee acknowledges, that the NHSCA Program Coordinator may schedule a site visit to the organization and may request a site visit from the NHSCA.
- The Grantee agrees to abide by the limitations, conditions and procedure outlined herein and in the attached appendices. If appropriated funds for this grants program are reduced or terminated, all payments under this grant may cease. That determination rests within the sole discretion of the Council.
- 3. PAYMENT will be made following the receipt and execution of all required documents and approval of the Governor and Executive Council
- 4. FINAL REPORT: The Grantee agrees to submit a final financial and narrative report on a form provided by the Council no more than 30 days after the end of the grant period. Failure to submit the final report will render the Grantee ineligible for Council funding for two years.
- 5. SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY: No provision of this contract is to be deemed a waiver of sovereign immunity by the State of New Hampshire.



Marc Thayer, Executive Director

Marc Thayer joined Symphony New Hampshire in Nashua as Executive Director in July, 2016. Previously Marc was the Deputy Director of the Association of American Voices (AV), a Cultural Diplomacy NGO with whom he has performed and taught in Iraq, Lebanon, Syria, Jordan, Ghana, Togo, Thailand, Burma and the Gaza Strip. With AV Marc continues to teach at the annual American Arts Festivals in Kurdistan, northern Iraq, and in Beirut, Lebanon. He co-managed the American Music Abroad Program for the US Department of State and served as a Cultural Envoy in Liberia in 2014 and 2015. From 2006-10 he served as the Artistic Producer for the Whim Estate Historical Society Concerts in St. Croix, Virgin Islands. Previously he was on the faculty of the Guadalquivir Festival with the National Symphony Orchestra of Bolivia.

Marc served as Director of Strings at Washington University in St. Louis and was a member of the Kingsbury Baroque Ensemble. He was the Music Director for the World Chess Hall of Fame Concert Series as well as founder and conductor of the Saint Louis University String Orchestra where he taught violin and viola.

From 2002-2011 Marc served as the Vice President for Education and Community Partnerships with the St. Louis Symphony and served as Director of Community Engagement with the New World Symphony in Miami Beach, FL, from 1999-2001. Marc performed as a member of the New World Symphony from 1995-1998 and founded their Education and Community Engagement Programs.

Marc has performed with the San Diego Symphony, Syracuse Symphony, Florida Philharmonic, American Russian Young Artists Orchestra, the Opera Festival of Heidelberg, Germany, the Orquesta Superior of Cordoba, Spain, the Ancient Music Festival of St. Savin, France, the Festival d'Orange, and with the International Festival of Art in Aix-en-Provence, France.

Marc received a Bachelors and Masters Degree in Violin Performance from the Eastman School of Music where he studied with William Preucil and Zvi Zeitlin.

Marc currently serves on the board of Arts4NH, an advocacy group dedicated to the arts and creativity in New Hampshire and is a member of the Nashua Arts Commission.
