Requested Action

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police to accept the donation of a Dayton Generator with a value of approximately \$750.00 and a Trailer Cargo with a value of approximately \$1,500.00 from the Defense Logistics Agency to be used by the Division of State Police Special Event Response Team (SERT). Effective upon Governor and Council approval.

Explanation

The Department of Safety has been given the opportunity to acquire the above mentioned equipment through the 1033 Program. The 1033 Program is the transfer of surplus military equipment from the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) to Law Enforcement. Every state has a 1033 Program which was created to reutilize surplus military equipment that would otherwise be destroyed.

State Police SERT will use the trailer to store and transport equipment commonly needed/used when deployed to a significant event. The generator will be used by State Police SERT to power items such as portable radios, flashlights, and other special tools required.
