Requested Action

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of Fire Safety, to accept the donation of a Burn Demonstration Unit, with an estimated value of \$18,000.00, from New Hampshire Fire Prevention Society to be available for the beginning of Fire Prevention Week on October 6, 2019. Effective upon Governor and Council approval.

Explanation

This Burn Demonstration Unit will be used during Fire Prevention Week to provide an excellent fire sprinkler demonstration prop to the State of New Hampshire and NH Fire Departments. The State Fire Marshal's Office will be responsible for maintaining the trailer, including all routine maintenance, to ensure all safety precautions are in place and to ensure the trailer is working properly. The Burn Demonstration Unit Side-by-Side trailer is one of the best educational tools that demonstrates the effectiveness of fire sprinklers. There are two side-by-side rooms constructed identically to each other. One is equipped with a sprinkler system, the other without. Then, a fire is ignited in each room. Home fire sprinklers are designed to activate when the air in the room reaches a certain temperature. As the temperature goes up in the sprinkler-protected side, the sprinklers will activate to control and, in many cases, extinguish the fire. In contrast, the fire in the room without sprinklers will show just how quickly a fire can grow to engulf a space.

The Burn Demonstration Unit Side-by-Side Trailer is being donated by the New Hampshire Fire Prevention Society. Agencies requesting to use the Burn Demonstration Unit will be required to provide their own furniture props for each demonstration.

Greetings Marshal Parisi,

As you are aware, the New Hampshire Fire Prevention Society, is and has been the voice of fire prevention in the state for many years. A little over four years ago, NHFPS started the NH Fire Sprinkler Coalition to expand our voice and reach out to the citizens of NH, educating them on the benefits of residential sprinklers in new and remodeled single and multi-family residential homes. This endeavor came to fruition with the assistance of the National Fire Protection Association, the National Fire Sprinkler Sprinkler Association, and your office under Fire Marshal, Bill Degnan.

The importance of this coalition was to educate not legislate. With this mindset, the coalition embarked on a journey that was extremely difficult but filled with reward. The main educational component to educating the public is with a side by side sprinkler demonstration. The coalition started down this path at the Eastern States Building Officials Federation Conference held in Portsmouth, NH in 2014. This was completed with a stick-built prop consisting of two burn cells, one sprinklered and one not.

After the first demonstration and subsequent experiences, it was decided to step up the motion and work to acquire a prop that could be self-contained and easier to deploy for area fire departments use. The NH Fire Sprinkler Coalition, under the parent organization NH Fire Prevention Society, with then President, Stephen Gallagher, National Fire Sprinkler Association Regional Director, Dave Lafond, and National Fire Protection Association Regional Director, Tim Travers, set out to acquire a new towable trailered prop a reality.

The cost of this new towable prop was \$18,000. A grant writing initiative was started and was a success. FM Global, National Fire Protection Association, and National Fire Sprinkler Association, provided grant money, enough to cover the entire construction build and delivery of the new prop.

Since the beginning of the sprinkler coalition and the many years of joint endeavors and educational missions between the New Hampshire Fire Prevention Society and the State Fire Marshal's office, the

sentiment for best use and practice of this new prop, has always maintained that the State Fire Marshals office needs to be an integral part of this mission to educate the general public on the benefits of residential sprinkler and sharing this message across the state.

It is with great pleasure I share with you the build has been completed. The Prop has been delivered and the NH Fire Prevention Society and the Sprinkler Coalition specifically, is ready to make the next move on this arduous journey. We would like to gift this \$18,000 side by side sprinkler demonstration prop trailer to the Office of The State Fire Marshal. The Society and Coalition feel that this would be the best use for this educational tool to be made available as a resource in the state for any fire chief wanting to share the benefits in their respective communities.

This road has been a long one. With continued efforts, cooperation, and collaboration, between the NH Fire Prevention Society, the Sprinkler Coalition and State Fire Marshal's Office I am confident that this educational tool will make an impact on saving lives, reducing property damage and providing economic relief to communities throughout New Hampshire.

The Trailer prop has an insurable value of \$18,000. There are no encumbrances, liens or liabilities and arrives with a marketable title.
