We made our posting on the Frankestown town website, and in hard copies posted at the Town Hall, Town Offices, Town Library, Village Store, Post Office, and elementary school. We also sent it to two Facebook sites that serve the community but are not officially affiliated with the town.

## **Updates for the November 3 General Election in Frankestown**

*\*The polls open at 8 AM and close at 7 PM; voting will take place at Town Hall.*

1. Frankestown Election Officials will **Pre-process Absentee Ballots** on Friday, October 30, from 9 AM to 1 PM in the lower level of the Town Offices building. This is a public event; any challenges to specific Absentee Ballots being pre-processed on October 30 must be made at this session. Challenges to these ballots will not be accepted on Election Day. Pre-Processing will be conducted according to the regulations set forth by the New Hampshire Secretary of State and Attorney General. Absentee Ballots received by the Clerk after October 29 will be processed during voting on November 3 beginning at 1 PM.
